Programmes:

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Admission to **Law programmes** offered at – Coimbatore campus for the Academic Year (AY) 2026-2027 is through and based on the rank scored in:

Amrita Common Law Admission Test (ACLAT) 2026

OR

Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) 2026 percentile

Students desirous of joining Law programs, after passing their plus two or equivalent examination are required to attend Amrita Common Law Admission Test 2026 or apply with the CLAT Percentile.

Rank in ACLAT 2026 is not mandatory if applied with CLAT 2026 Percentile.

Admission to **Law programmes** offered at our Coimbatore campus of Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham is fully managed by Directorate of Admissions.

ELIGIBILITY & CRITERIA

Age: No maximum age restriction for candidates seeking admission to the undergraduate program for ACLAT 2026.

EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants who have studied and passed through regular, full-time and formal education with English. Eligible candidates must have successfully completed 10+2 or an equivalent qualification, securing at least 60% marks in the +2 examination from a recognized credentialing authority.

Candidates appearing for their qualifying exams in March/April 2026 may also apply. However, it is mandatory to submit proof of passing the qualifying exam at the time of admission. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of admission eligibility.

Nationality

- ❖ The applicant for Law shall be a Resident / Non-Resident Indian National / OCI / PIO Holder.
- ❖ Foreign applicants who studied/studying abroad can apply through Amrita Center for International Programmes (<https://www.amrita.edu/international>).

Qualifying Examination

- Candidates appearing for ACLAT–2026 must have completed, or be appearing in, any one of the following qualifying examinations

- The final examination of the 10+2 system, conducted by any recognized Central / State Board, such as the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE) or any other Board accepted by Amrita as equivalent to 10+2 examination.
- Intermediate or two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by a recognized Board / University.
- General Certificate Education (GCE) examination (London / Cambridge / Sri Lanka) at the Advanced (A) level.
- High School Certificate Examination of the Cambridge University or International Baccalaureate Diploma of the International Baccalaureate Office, Geneva.
- Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National Institute of Open Schooling with minimum of 5 subjects as recognized by Central Board.

Note:

- ❖ Applicants who have completed the Class 12 (or equivalent) examination outside India should produce an equivalence certificate to the effect that the examination they have passed is equivalent to the Class 12 Examination with Grade / CGPA converted to percentage.
- ❖ Applicants who have appeared for multiple board examinations in the same academic year are not eligible.

ACLAT/CLAT 2026 SEAT ALLOCATION for LAW PROGRAMS

A candidate can choose to apply either through ACLAT or CLAT 2026 individually or even select both. The above percentage is only a guideline and will be decided at the time of centralized seat allotment process.	

- All seat allocations and admission offer via ACLAT 2026 are provisional. Provisional allotment will be sent only by email, candidates are required to login to the portal to accept the offer letter.

AMRITA COMMON LAW ADMISSION TEST (ACLAT) 2026) will be conducted in **Computer Based Test (CBT)** mode in designated centres. All updates will be posted on the official website.

ACLAT 2026 is administered and conducted by Directorate of Admissions, Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham, for admission to its prestigious Law programs offered at its Coimbatore (Main) campus. ACLAT is a national-level exam, known for its rigorous and fair assessment of candidates’ aptitude in subjects **like Legal Reasoning, Current Affairs & General Knowledge, English, Logical Reasoning, Quantitative Techniques**. ACLAT offers students a gateway to join one of India’s top-ranked private institutions, renowned for its high academic standards, world-class academic infrastructure.

By attending ACLAT, candidates get the opportunity to study in a diverse and vibrant environment, with access to scholarship seats, global exposure, and cutting-edge learning resources, making Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham a preferred choice for aspiring lawyers.

ACLAT 2026 CITIES

ACLAT 2026 will be conducted in designated cities in India. An indicative list of cities for ACLAT 2026 is appended at the end of this handbook in APPENDIX – I. ACLAT 2026 will be conducted in a center in these cities, provided there are enough candidates. University will put all efforts to conduct examinations at all the listed cities. If any city in the list is cancelled due to very less registrations or for any other reason, the candidates who have opted for that city will be allotted to another city nearest to their preference and the same will be informed to the candidates by email.

Choose three cities listed to attend the examination. A candidate appearing for ACLAT 2026 shall submit three preferences to proceed with the registration. The preferences submitted by the candidate are only indicative and a guide to the University for deciding the number of ACLAT 2026 centers in each city. A candidate will be allotted one out of the three preferred cities, preferably the first preferred city. If exam cannot be conducted at the first preferred city of a candidate, for any reason whatsoever, he / she will be allotted to second / third preference as applicable.

REQUESTS FOR CHANGE OF CITY

The requests for change of cities will not be entertained after the application submission. The decision of the Admission Committee will be final in case of any such requests raised in this regard.

Important Note:

- (i) The number of days and slots of the Examination will be changed/reduced depending on the strength of the candidates. *
- (ii) **Dates may get deferred -**
 - a) Based on the government notifications
 - b) In case there is any other major examination scheduled on these dates and / or due to which majority of the candidates are unable to appear for ACLAT 2026.
 - c) Because of some other reason
- (iii) University holds the right to defer the mode / State / City / Venue / dates / slots of the examinations as per the situation, whatsoever, prevailing at that time.
- (iv) Candidates are advised to check the registered email or visit the website regularly for the latest updates.

Online Application form for ACLAT 2026 (Points to be noted)

- Application for ACLAT 2026 shall be submitted ONLINE via <https://applyug.amrita.edu/law> only.
- The candidates are advised to have their own personal and valid email ID and mobile No. The candidates are advised to retain the registered mobile number and email-id they have used to submit the application, till all the admission procedures are completed as all important updates will be informed to the candidates through SMS / e-mail or both to the registered mobile No. /e-mail ID. Both email-ID and mobile number will be verified using OTP.
- The name of the candidate and his/her parents' name in the application form must exactly be the same as registered in Class 10th Certificate. Prefix/title such as Mr./Shri/Fr/Dr/Mrs./Smt./Col etc., must not be used.
- Ensure name of candidate and parents are spelled correctly in the application, matching certificates to be produced at the time of admission. Any discrepancies may lead to disqualification.
- Once submitted, changes are not allowed. No updates will be allowed after the application deadline.
- Any request for change data submitted at any stage will not be considered under any circumstances.
- AMRITA will not entertain the corrections sent by the candidates through Post/Fax/WhatsApp/E-mail/Online request/ in person.
- Multiple applications will not be accepted and will lead to the cancellation of the admission.
- Provide only correct and honest information. Discrepancies found at any stage will result in cancellation of provisional admission. If reservation eligibility is affected by a mismatch, the candidate will be considered for admission without that reservation in subsequent rounds.
- Test city/centre changes may occur due to unforeseen circumstances; the Admission Committee may reassign candidates to the best location possible.
- Produce certificates as prescribed by competent authorities to claim reservation benefits.
- Submit proof of qualifying examination (10+2) at admission, otherwise admission will be denied.
- Indian Nationals/NRI Sponsored candidates may attend ACLAT 2026.
- Foreign nationals must apply through the Amrita Centre for International Programmes (<https://www.amrita.edu/international>)
- For NRI/NRI-sponsored seats, refer to e-brochures/website <https://amrita.edu/nriadmission>.
- Candidates are required to register for ACLAT 2026 before the date mentioned in the website.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered. Apply early to avoid last-minute issues.
- Details on intake, reservations, courses, and fees is published in the Information Brochure in the above website. Review these details thoroughly before applying.
- For additional information, visit university website or accompanying e-Brochure.
- Candidates should check the ACLAT 2026 website regularly.

Documents Required for Online Application

1. Recent, front-facing passport-size photo (plain background) & signature in .jpg format.

NOTE:

- Candidates must present the original documents for verification at the time of admission, as required by the university rules.
- Photo and signature need not be attested for online submission.

Registration / Application Fee: INR 1000/-

- The application fee payment is ONLY online and will not be accepted through any other means.
- Bank transaction charges are the applicant's responsibility.
- Application fee once paid will not be refunded / adjusted (full or partial) under any circumstances. However, excess fee paid because of payment failures will be reimbursed by the University.

SYLLABUS, PATTERN AND EVALUATION**ACLAT 2026 – PATTERN**

The ACLAT 2026 focuses on assessing applicants' comprehension and reasoning abilities. The test is designed to measure aptitude and skills necessary for legal education; existing knowledge may sometimes assist, especially in responding to questions in the Current Affairs and General Knowledge section.

- The ACLAT 2026 is a two-hour examination with 120 multiple-choice questions (MCQs), each carrying 3 marks. There is a penalty of -1 marks for each incorrect answer.
- The test covers five main subjects:
 - English Language
 - Current Affairs, including General Knowledge
 - Legal Reasoning
 - Logical Reasoning
 - Quantitative Techniques
- All the questions are of **multiple-choice type** and will have four options as possible answers.

ACLAT 2026 - SYLLABUS**English Language**

This section includes passages of approximately 450 words, sourced from contemporary or significant fiction and non-fiction. The reading level is set so that a 12th-grade student can complete it in about 5-7 minutes. After each passage, questions will test candidates' ability to:

- Identify the primary topic and arguments within the passage.
- Draw conclusions and inferences.
- Summarize the content.
- Compare and contrast various perspectives presented.
- Interpret the meaning of words or phrases in contextual usage.

Current Affairs & General Knowledge

Passages of up to 450 words will be taken from news, journalistic, and other non-fiction works. Some questions may touch upon legal topics as discussed in the passages, but no additional legal knowledge is required beyond the provided content. Questions will focus on:

- Noteworthy contemporary events in India and worldwide.
- Arts and cultural issues.
- International affairs.
- Historical events of lasting importance.

Legal Reasoning

Covers passages (~450 words) presenting factual scenarios, legal dilemmas, policy matters, or philosophical questions. Prior legal knowledge is not necessary; general awareness of present-day legal and ethical issues will aid in applying principles to the scenarios.

Questions are designed to:

- Identify rules and principles stated in the passage.
- Apply these principles to hypothetical situations.
- Assess how changes in rules would affect their application.

Logical Reasoning

Contains short passages (~450 words) followed by questions aimed at:

- Recognizing arguments, premises, and conclusions.
- Identifying and analysing arguments.
- Evaluating reasoning patterns and determining how changing premises affects conclusions.
- Drawing inferences and applying them to novel situations.
- Locating relationships, analogies, contradictions, and evaluating argument effectiveness.

Quantitative Techniques

Includes sets of numerical data, facts, or text-based representations requiring mathematical analysis. Tasks involve:

- Extracting and manipulating numerical data from the passage.
- Applying 10th-grade level mathematics such as ratios, algebra, mensuration, and basic Statistics.

Exam Preparation

Candidates preparing for ACLAT 2026 may utilize CLAT preparatory materials and resources for their studies, as the overall areas of assessment and analytical approach are broadly similar. Standard CLAT preparation books, practice papers, and mock tests can help candidates develop skills in reading comprehension, logical reasoning, legal aptitude, and general awareness, which are essential for performing well in ACLAT.

However, candidates are advised to also refer to the official guidelines and examination pattern prescribed for ACLAT 2026 to ensure their preparation remains aligned with the specific requirements of the examination.

SLOT BOOKING FOR ACLAT 2026

- **Candidates shall choose 3 dates of their choice to attend ACLAT 2026.**
- Date & slot allotment is an automated process. Date & slot will be allotted 7 days prior to the first examination date. The candidates are advised to check the website regularly for the latest updates.

Admit Card for ACLAT 2026:

- Admit Card is issued to the candidate to attend ACLAT 2026. Admit Card is generated only to those eligible candidates who have booked their slot. Slots can be booked only if the ACLAT 2026 registration is completed in all respects.
- Admit Card can be downloaded by logging into your account. Issuance date will be announced on the website.
- The Admit Card will not be dispatched to the candidates via post/fax/ e-mail.
- The Admit Card will have details like the Name & Registration Number of the candidate, Date of Exam, Address of the Exam Centre allotted etc. printed.
- Ensure that the data is printed as submitted by you online during the registration process.
- Candidates are not permitted to appear for the test without valid Admit Card.
- The Admit Card is an important document and it must be produced at the time of examination & admission.
- Request from a candidate for change of city allotted to him/her will NOT be entertained under any circumstances.
- Candidate should report to the test centre with the physical copy of admit card and any one of the document for photo identification - Aadhar Card / Passport / Driving License / Voter ID Card / PAN Card (preferably Aadhar Card) to verify your identity.
- Issue of Admit Cards does not mean acceptance of eligibility for admission.
- In the case of an eligible candidate, whose application form is incomplete, the application will not be processed for the issue of an admit card.

ACLAT 2026 – GUIDELINES FOR CANDIDATES:

- Candidates shall appear for ACLAT 2026 at the centre at their own cost on the date & slot as printed on the Admit Card.
- Candidates are not permitted to appear more than once by duplicate application. Any attempt more than once will result in the disqualification of candidacy.
- Candidates are required to report at the examination centre at least 1 hour prior to the scheduled time of the examination.
- Registration at the examination centre is mandatory. Computer to attend the examination is allotted only at the time of registration at the centre.
- It is mandatory to carry the Admit Card and Aadhaar card (preferred) to verify your identity. The details on the Aadhaar card shall match with the details entered during the online registration.
- The candidate must show, on demand, the Admit Card to enter the lab and should also produce the Admit Card when demanded by the invigilator in the examination centre.
- The candidates shall occupy their seats 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the examination. Candidates are likely to miss some of the general instructions to be announced in the lab in the event of late arrival.
- Candidates shall occupy only their allotted seat. If any candidate is found to have changed the seat other than the allotted one, his/her ACLAT 2026 candidature will be cancelled, and no plea would be accepted.
- The examination will start at the time mentioned in the Admit Card. In an unforeseen event of a late commencement because of power failure or any technical reason, time will be given as per the rules to each candidate to complete the examination.
- Candidates arriving late will not have any time extended to complete the examination.
- The invigilator will check the Admit Card of the candidate to satisfy the identity of each candidate anytime during the examination.
- Use of electronic devices like mobile phones, calculators etc. are NOT PERMITTED for ACLAT 2026. Materials like log table, book, notebook, Instruments, any kind of paper, stationery, Textual material. (printed or written), watches with facilities of calculator, any metallic item or electronic gadgets/devices etc. should NOT be brought into the examination hall for CBT. Candidates are also hereby warned not to use the calculator in the computer while taking the test. Any candidate found to have used the computer calculator will be debarred from admission.
- Rough sheets will be provided in the examination hall for the rough work and should be handed over to the invigilators after the examination.
- Candidates will be monitored through CCTV camera in the examination hall.
- If a candidate indulges in any kind of malpractice like possession of prohibited items inside the examination hall, possession of electronic gadgets, possession of materials relating to examination, assisting other candidates in the examination hall, writing questions and answers in the rough sheet/hall ticket, contacting/communicating with the other candidates in the examination hall, exchange of physical materials with the other candidates, approaching the Invigilator/Test Centre people proposing unfair, threatening/arguing with the officials/other candidates, forceful entry/exit into/from the examination hall, affixing/uploading wrong/morphed photograph/signature on the application form/admit card, breaching examination rules in connection with ACLAT 2026 examination from time to time, etc., he/she shall be deemed to have used unfair practices and booked under Malpractice Cases.
- Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham has the right to hold the result and cancel the candidacy of the candidates appearing more than once, impersonation, or any other malpractice at the time of giving the exam and/or any other action as deemed fit.
- Candidates are to approach only the Invigilator in the room for any technical assistance, first aid emergency, or for any other information during the examination.
- In case a candidate, by furnishing false information, appears in more than one slot/date in a particular phase, his/her candidature will be cancelled, and his/her result will not be declared.

CODE OF CONDUCT DURING ACLAT 2026

The candidates are governed by the Rules and Regulations of the University regarding their conduct during the examination. All cases of unfair means will be dealt with as per university rules and government rules/policies/laws. Candidates shall maintain perfect silence and attend to their exam only. Any conversation or gesture or disturbance during the examination shall be deemed as misbehavior.

If a candidate is found using unfair means or impersonating, his/her candidature shall be cancelled, and he/she will be liable to be debarred for taking examination either permanently or for a specified period according to the nature of offence. The decision of the Admission Committee is final and is binding on the candidate.

The result of the candidate(s) who indulges in unfair means / practices will be cancelled and will not be declared. Similarly, the result of those candidates who appear from the centre other than the one allotted to them or allow another candidate/person to write the examination on his behalf will be cancelled. No plea will be entertained in this regard.

ACLAT 2026 RESULTS

ACLAT 2026 rank will be released for all the candidates who have appeared in Amrita Common Law Admission Test 2026 provided the candidate has not indulged in any sort of malpractice and /or against the rules and regulations of the examination as laid by the University. Candidates will be able to view their results in the admission portal.

Provisional Admission will be cancelled if the candidate does not meet the eligibility norms
