UR	5	Besides clearing GAT-B, a candidate must have passed B.Sc. (Agri)/ B.Sc. (Hort.)/ B.Sc. (Agri. Biotech)/ B.Sc. (Seri)/ B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture / Horticulture/ Fisheries/ Forestry/ Sericulture/ Home/ Community Science, from AAU or any other recognized university, securing a minimum CGPA of 6.60/10 or 3.25/5 or 2.60/4 for Gen./OBC-NCL/EWS category and 5.60/10 or 2.75/5 or 2.20/4 for SC/ST category. OR Passed B.Sc. in Biology/ Botany/ Zoology/ Life Sciences/ Biotechnology/ Bioinformatics/ Biochemistry/ Microbiology from a recognized university. OR Passed B.Tech. in relevant discipline of Biotechnology or Life Sciences from a recognized university. In the case where Grade Points are not awarded and only marks are awarded, the candidate must have secured at least 60.00% marks for Gen./OBC-NCL/EWS category, and at least 50.00% for SC/ST category. Students admitted to M.Sc. in Molecular Biology and Biotechnology through the GAT-B examination are entitled to receive fellowship as per DBT norms.
