### 1 Introduction

The Bihar School Examination Board (BSEB) prescribes the exam pattern for Class 12 board examinations for the academic year 2025-26. This document provides a comprehensive overview of the exam pattern, including question types, marking schemes, and subject-wise details for Science, Commerce, and Arts streams. The exam pattern is designed to assess students' theoretical and practical knowledge, with a balanced distribution of objective and subjective questions. Students are advised to refer to the official BSEB website for any updates or revisions.

## 2 General Exam Pattern

The BSEB Class 12 examinations are conducted in offline mode (pen-and-paper) and consist of both theoretical and practical components (where applicable). The key features of the exam pattern are as follows:

- **Question Types**: 50% Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) and 50% Subjective Questions (short and long-answer types).
- MCQs:
  - For subjects with a 100-mark theory paper: 60 MCQs (50 to be attempted, 1 mark each).
  - For subjects with a 70-mark theory paper (with practicals): 42 MCQs
    (35 to be attempted, 1 mark each).
  - For subjects with a 50-mark theory paper: 30 MCQs (25 to be attempted, 1 mark each).
- **Subjective Questions**: Include short-answer (2 marks each) and long-answer questions (5 marks each, except in language papers where questions may exceed 5 marks).
- **Exam Duration**: 3 hours and 15 minutes (including 15 minutes for reading the question paper).

- **Passing Marks**: Minimum 30% marks in each subject (30 out of 100 for theory, adjusted for practicals where applicable).
- Additional Subject Rule: If a student fails a compulsory subject, marks from an additional subject may be considered for passing.

# 3 Subject-Wise Exam Pattern

The exam pattern varies by stream and subject. Below is the detailed structure for key subjects in each stream.

#### 3.1 Science Stream

- Physics, Chemistry, Biology:
  - **Theory**: 70 marks
    - \* 42 MCQs (35 to attempt, 35 marks)
    - \* 18 Short-answer questions (2 marks each, 10 to attempt, 20 marks)
    - \* 6 Long-answer questions (5 marks each, 3 to attempt, 15 marks)
  - Practical: 30 marks (15 for lab experiments, 10 for viva, 5 for practical copy)
- Mathematics:
  - Theory: 100 marks
    - \* 60 MCQs (50 to attempt, 50 marks)
    - \* 25 Short-answer questions (2 marks each, 15 to attempt, 30 marks)
    - \* 8 Long-answer questions (5 marks each, 5 to attempt, 25 marks)

#### 3.2 Commerce Stream

- Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics:
  - Theory: 100 marks
    - \* 60 MCQs (50 to attempt, 50 marks)
    - \* 25 Short-answer questions (2 marks each, 15 to attempt, 30 marks)
    - \* 8 Long-answer questions (5 marks each, 5 to attempt, 25 marks)
- Entrepreneurship:
  - **Theory**: 70 marks
    - \* 42 MCQs (35 to attempt, 35 marks)
    - \* 18 Short-answer questions (2 marks each, 10 to attempt, 20 marks)
    - \* 6 Long-answer questions (5 marks each, 3 to attempt, 15 marks)
  - **Practical**: 30 marks

#### 3.3 Arts Stream

- History, Political Science, Sociology, English, Hindi, Other Languages:
  - Theory: 100 marks
    - \* 60 MCQs (50 to attempt, 50 marks)
    - \* 25 Short-answer questions (2 marks each, 15 to attempt, 30 marks)
    - \* 8 Long-answer questions (5 marks or more, 5 to attempt, 25 marks)
- Geography, Psychology:
  - **Theory**: 70 marks
    - \* 42 MCQs (35 to attempt, 35 marks)
    - \* 18 Short-answer questions (2 marks each, 10 to attempt, 20 marks)
    - \* 6 Long-answer questions (5 marks each, 3 to attempt, 15 marks)
  - **Practical**: 30 marks

### 4 Practical Exam Pattern

For subjects with practical components (e.g., Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Geography, Psychology, Entrepreneurship):

- Total Marks: 30
  - Lab Experiments: 15 marksViva/Oral Test: 10 marksPractical Copy: 5 marks
- Dates: Conducted from January 10 to January 20, 2025, at students' respective schools.
- **Guidelines**: Students must prepare at least 5 experiments, include an index in the practical copy, and carry all required documents to the exam.

- **Practice Previous Papers**: Solve past years' question papers to understand question patterns and improve time management.
