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1. Jamia Millia Islamia

Jamia Millia Islamia was founded at Aligarh in response to Gandhi Ji's call to boycott British-supported educational institutions. Shaikhul-Hind, Maulana Mahmud Hasan of Dar-ul-Uloom, Deoband, a victim of the British imperial viciousness in the Mediterranean Island of Malta, laid its foundation at Aligarh on 29th October 1920. Subsequently, in 1925, it moved from Aligarh to Delhi. Ever since then, Jamia has shown a gradual, but continuous growth, at times in spurts and gushes, and others through prolonged processes of slow maturation.

A 'Deemed to be University' status was bestowed to the Jamia in June 1963 under Section 2 of the University Grants Commission Act and eventually, on 26 December 1988, through an Act of the Indian Parliament, the Jamia blossomed into a full-fledged Central University.

Distinguished national leaders - Mahatma Gandhi, Maulana Mohammed Ali Jauhar, Hakim Ajmal Khan, Dr. Mukhtar Ahmad Ansari, Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, and Dr. Zakir Husain were among its founders.

Accredited A++ by NAAC along with an NIRF University Ranking 3rd in 2023, Jamia Millia Islamia is an ensemble of multi-layered educational system, which covers all aspects of schooling, undergraduate, and post-graduate education. The university recognizes that teaching and research are complementary components in its march toward academic excellence. Moreover, Jamia Millia Islamia is amongst the few universities in India launching online Degree Programmes making the education more reachable to learners across the world.

The Jamia Millia Islamia has well-developed 11 faculties namely Sciences; Life Sciences, Social Sciences; Engineering and Technology; Education; Humanities and Languages; Architecture and Ekistics; Fine Arts; Law; Management Studies, and Dentistry. The 11 faculties have been divided into 42 departments. In addition to these JMI has 30 centres of learning like AJK Mass Communication Research Centre, The Centre for Peace and Conflict Resolution; Academy of International Studies; Centre for Culture, Media and Governance; Dr. K. R. Narayanan Centre for Dalit and Minorities Studies; Centre for Nano-sciences and Nanotechnology; FTK Centre for Information Technology; Centre for West Asian Studies; Centre for Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation Sciences; Centre for Theoretical Physics; and Centre for Interdisciplinary Research in Basic Sciences, etc.

Indeed, the Jamia has come a long way in her march to carve a 'distinct' niche in the academic world as a Centre for higher learning without compromising or altering her foundational values of secularism and democracy and her commitment to a composite Indian nationalism.

2. Centre for Distance and Online Education

The Centre for Distance and Open Learning (CDOL), now re-designated as Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE), was established at Jamia Millia Islamia in September 2002 under the auspices of the Distance Education Council (DEC) currently rechristened as Distance Education Bureau (DEB). In 2009, the CDOL, now CDOE, was approved by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India (GoI).

The objectives of the Centre include the provision of space for higher education to those who are inaccessible to the benefits of a formal system of education and to take education to the doorstep of the learner.

The Centre provides comprehensive self-learning material (SLM), which is supplemented by counselling sessions. The self-learning material is prepared by the subject experts keeping in mind that the learners come from varied educational backgrounds so that they can make optimum use of the material. Moreover, the counselling classes are taken by senior faculty members who have been a source of great help to distance-mode learners. Given the changing situation and time, the Centre has also adapted the new technological advancement to conduct the counselling sessions through online platforms. However, ODL counselling sessions (offline) are also conducted in the various study centers in the University as well as at LSCs. Thus, a blended mode of learning has been adopted at the Centre.

The Centre has established Learner Support Centres located at various locations across India such as Assam, Bihar, Haryana, Kerala, Punjab, Rajasthan, UP, West Bengal, Delhi & NCR. These LSCs also play a significant role in reaching out to learners hailing from rural areas.

2.1 Open and Distance Learning (ODL) & Online Learning (OL) Mode Programmes

“**Online Learning Mode** means a mode of providing flexible learning opportunities by overcoming separation of teacher and learner using internet, e-Learning Materials and full- fledged programme delivery through the internet using technology assisted mechanism and resources”.

“**Open and Distance Learning Mode** means a mode of providing flexible learning opportunities by overcoming separation of teacher and learner using a variety of media, including print, electronic, online and occasional interactive face-to-face meetings with the learners or Learner Support Services to deliver teaching-learning experiences, including practical or work experiences”.

The Centre for Distance and Online Education, JMI is one of the few reputed Higher Education Institutes to provide the UG, PG, and Diploma Programmes in Open and Distance Learning (ODL) as well as Online Learning (OL) mode. CDOE has been providing Online Degree programmes since 2021. The Centre aims to make optimum use of technological advancement in imparting Education through the Online Mode and facilitate the learners with ease. Given the recent developments in the area of education and resultant positive changes, the Centre has also adopted varied Online Methods of Evaluation and Online Teaching. Such use of technology has bridged a gap between the learner and facilitator and made education more accessible to learners based in far-flung areas. Moreover, these Online Programmes are also accessible to Foreign Nationals who are interested in pursuing education at our Institute.

Personality by choosing subjects across disciplines and mediums. The CDOE would like to encourage interdisciplinary among students in their studies. To facilitate this, a cumulative list of courses that will run under CBCS is being provided. Students are advised to go through the list carefully so that they can make an informed choice. Assistant Professors or Programme Coordinators may be contacted for advice or any other help related to the CBCS.

2.2 Centre for Internal Quality Assurance (CIQA)

The UGC (ODL) Regulations 2020 make it mandatory for dual-mode universities to establish a Centre for Internal Quality Assurance (CIQA) exclusively for their distance mode programmes. The objective of CIQA is to develop and put in place a comprehensive and

dynamic quality assurance system to provide high-quality programmes of higher education in the distance and online learning mode. Accordingly, the Vice Chancellor constituted the CIQA Committee to monitor the qualitative mechanism of the Centre; the committee consisted of the following members:

2.4 Instructional System

The distance and online education programme delivery system includes the multi-media approach, i.e., self-learning material available in hard copy and soft copy (PDFs), audio/video components, assignments, counselling sessions, practical work, discussion forums, and workshops.

2.5 Learner Support Centres (LSCs)

“**Learner Support Centre** means a center established or recognised by the Higher Educational Institution for advising, counselling, providing interface between the teachers and the learners, rendering any academic and any other related service and assistance required, inter alia, by the learners of Open and Distance Learning mode”.

It is a contact point to provide academic as well as administrative support to its learners. All the important communications are sent to the Centre Coordinator of the Learner Support Centre. A copy of important circulars/notifications will be displayed on the noticeboard of the Learner Support Centre to provide the latest information about the assignments, submission of the examination forms, date sheet, list of admitted students, declaration of result, etc. Extracurricular activities encouraged at the Learner Support Centre like Annual Day, Sports Day, Literary Competitions, etc. are held and encouraged.

2.6 Self-Learning Material (SLM)


The e-copy (soft copy) of Self Learning Material for both theory and practical components for each programme of study is provided to all the learners of ODL as well as OL mode. The PDFs of the SLM are uploaded to the Google Classroom of each respective programme. The SLM of each course/paper in each programme is prepared in the form of blocks and units. Normally each course is divided into 3 – 5 blocks and each block contains 3 – 5 units. The code for each course under each programme is different so that it may be identified and accessed comfortably.

The fee for the e-copy of SLM is included in the programme fee. However, the hardcopy of the SLM is provided ON DEMAND to the learners of ODL mode only as per the following extra charges:

Note:

1. In online mode, there is no provision of On Demand Print SLM. Online mode is devoted towards a paperless and environmentally sustainable approach.
2. In ODL (Open and Distance Learning) mode all students are supplied with the soft copy of SLM (PDF/e-form of SLM), but there is a provision of providing SLM in print form/hard copy on demand. We encourage students to use e-SLM and be environmentally sustainable in their approach, but still if they need to have the hard copy of SLM they may submit the requisition form along with the DD/payment receipt of the required amount (as shown in table above) at the LSC counter.

2.7 Audio and Video Programmes

The Audio and Video Programmes are supplementary, meant for clarification and enhancement of understanding in various courses of the Programme. These are used during Counselling and workshop sessions at the Learner Support Centres. The information regarding Online Educational Resources (OERs) shall be made available to the learners during counselling sessions.

2.8 Library Facility

The CDOE has developed its own library with around 1000 books. In addition, the library has the facility of air conditioned reading room. The library facility can be availed with the permission of the Concerned Programmed coordinator.

2.9 Counselling Sessions

Counselling sessions are held at the study centers normally on weekends and long holidays within the general academic schedule of the Programme. The counselling schedules are shared by the LSCs and the Programme Coordinators well in time before the start of counselling sessions through Google Classrooms as well as the CDOE webpage ([https://www.jmi.ac.in/Centre-For-Distance-And-Online-Education-\(CDOE\)/Counselling/-Workshop-Schedule](https://www.jmi.ac.in/Centre-For-Distance-And-Online-Education-(CDOE)/Counselling/-Workshop-Schedule)). The counselling duration and time for each theory course will consist of 6 sessions of 2 hours each.

The **counselling sessions for ODL Programmes** are held at the Learner Support Centres. However, the CDOE has decided to conduct the counselling sessions in a blended mode as per UGC-DEB guidelines. For **Online Learning (OL) programmes**, all the counselling sessions and all other academic activities are conducted in purely online mode.

The counselling sessions are taken by faculty members and experts from the field. The counselling sessions will include clarifications required in the SLM and other related difficulties through active interaction with students. Attending counselling sessions is optional, however, presence and participation in the counselling session are highly beneficial for the learners and their academic growth. The e-SLM in the form of videos and PDFs will be uploaded on the respective Google Classrooms.

2.10 Medium of Instructions

In most of the programme of study, the medium of instruction is English. The self-learning materials and assignments in the programmes will be primarily available in English. For the Post Graduate programmes, the semester-end question papers will be in English only. Students can attempt their assignments and Term-End/Semester-End examination papers either in English, Hindi, or Urdu.

2.11 Website

Jamia Millia Islamia has a comprehensive website that is consistently updated with new notifications and updates about exams, counselling sessions, etc. The students are advised to make good use of the website to keep them updated with the new happenings at the University. The Office of the Controller of the Examinations has its own website that can be accessed for filling up online admission forms and examination forms and for checking the schedule and results of the examinations. The link to the website is <http://jmicoe.in>.

2.12 Assessment and Evaluation System

Evaluation System is divided into two parts at CDOE, Jamia Millia Islamia:

(i) Formative Assessment:

- Theory / Practical Assignments
- Dissertation/Workshop / Project Work / Practical/Viva-Voce (wherever applicable)

(ii) Summative Assessment

- Term End/Semester Examination

All the above are compulsory components for a learner of each programme of study (wherever applicable) to successfully complete the programme.

2.12.1 Term-End/Semester-End Examinations

The University conducts a Term-End Examination once a year and students are advised to take their examination at the end of each academic year, while the Semester-End Examinations are held twice a year at the end of each semester.

The examinations of ODL programmes are conducted through offline mode in the Jamia Millia Islamia campus and at different Learner Support Centres. However, for the online programmes, the examinations are conducted through Proctored Online Mode as per the UGC guidelines which are duly notified on the website of the office of the Controller of Examinations, Jamia Millia Islamia.

2.12.2 Theory/Practical Assignments

Assignments are an integral and compulsory component of the instructional system. The students will have to work on a specified number of assignments per programme. These assignments are to be submitted at the Learner Support Centre following the submission schedule provided by Programme Coordinator / In-Charge of the respective centers. The assignments are submitted through Google Classroom of respective programme.

Dissertation / Workshop/ Project / Practical / Viva-Voce

In several programmes of study, students are required to do Dissertations / Projects / Practical, etc. (wherever applicable) as part of their coursework. These activities enable the students to have practical exposure and in-field experience. The Viva-Voce (if any) is held so that the learner may defend the practical activity that he/she has done during his/her Dissertation/Project/Practical.

2.13 Grievance Redressal Cell



5. General Guidelines

Candidates are required to read the prospectus carefully before filling out the Application Form for admission to any Programme of study in CDOE, Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi. The Prospectus provides general information and is subject to the provisions of the Act, Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations, and relevant Resolutions of the Academic Council/Executive Council of Jamia.

The University reserves the right to change/modify the provisions made in this prospectus by notifying through addendum/corrigendum on the University website. Candidates shall not be informed of any such change individually and are advised to check the University website (<http://jmi.ac.in/CDOE/>) regularly.

5.1 Application/Registration Fee for Admission/ Entrance Test

- (i) The application for admission may only be submitted through Online mode at Jamia Millia Islamia Website www.jmicoe.in. There is no printed application form for admission.
- (ii) While applying, the candidate is required to make a payment of the Application Fee as prescribed below:

- (iii) The application fee may be paid either by Credit Card/Debit Card/ Net Banking.
- (iv) The application fee once received successfully at JMI's end is non-refundable and no correspondence on this subject will be entertained.
- (v) JMI shall only refund the application fee in cases of failed transactions identified at its end.

5.2 Submission of Application Form

- (i) Candidates are advised to carefully read and follow the instructions provided online during the Form Submission Process.
- (ii) To register for admission, candidates are required to use the online form available at JMI's Admission Portal: www.jmicoe.in
- (iii) Before applying for admission, a candidate is advised to ensure his/her eligibility as per the criteria laid down in the prospectus.
- (iv) A candidate must have passed the qualifying examination from a board/university/institute recognized by JMI. Jamia Millia Islamia recognizes degrees from all central universities, state universities, institutions of national importance, and foreign universities, provided that their equivalence has been established by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU). Besides, the university also recognizes certain qualifications from the reputed madrasas as well, the details of which are provided in Annexure– I of the prospectus.
- (v) Candidates whose results for the qualifying examinations have not been declared may also apply. However, for programmes whose eligibility is bachelor's degree, etc, they must submit the required certificates, etc. (of first declared result) within a given time period, failing which their admission will be cancelled.
- (vi) During the Registration process, the following information/details should be available with the candidate:
 - **Academic Bank of Credit ID (ABC ID) and UGC 'DEB-ID'. Both these IDs are to be created by the applicants themselves.**

- (vii) Candidates may use the preview option to cross-check the correctness of entries filled by them online before confirming the submission of the application form. Any required correction(s) except in "Name" and "Date-of-Birth" in the registration information may be made before completing/Confirming the registration portion in the form. The detailed guidelines for editing will be published on www.jmicoe.in.

- (viii) Once the registration of admission form is successfully submitted the system will send an email bearing the Unique Code with a link to verify the email account, and login (email address), and password to access the account to the registered email address. After link verification, and using an email address and password, the candidate may login to the portal and proceed to apply for the program(s) of his/her choice and pay the applicable entrance application fees.
- (ix) In case of submission of an Online form through Cyber Cafe/at any other place, a candidate is also advised to go through the guidelines and get the form filled in his/her presence and provide his/her contact information such as email and mobile number wherever required. The University will not be responsible for any mistake made by the candidate while filling out the admission form.

5.3 Rejection of Application Form

Jamia Millia Islamia reserves the right to reject the application form(s) if a candidate submits more than one application form for the same Programmes of study and for any other reason.

5.4 Conditions of Admission Cancellation

- (i) If a candidate fails to submit his/her result/certificate for the qualifying examination(s) or fails to complete any of the other admission formalities by the last date as notified by the University for the Concerned Program in this prospectus or on the University website.
- (ii) At any stage, if any information furnished by the candidate is found to be incorrect or if a candidate has been wrongly admitted.
- (iii) The candidate has to prove his/her academic records mentioned in the online application form, at the time of admission in CDOE and concerned Learner Support Centres, failing which admission will not be granted. Filling online admission form and issue of admit card does not guarantee admission.

6. Verification of Documents & Payment of Admission Fees

- (ix) Must have passed the qualifying examination from a recognized Board/University/Institute.
- (x) Mention complete correspondence/postal address (in CAPITAL LETTERS only) with postal PIN code and contact telephone/mobile number.

- a. *The Jamia Millia Islamia recognizes degrees from all Central Universities, State Universities, Institutions of national importance, and Foreign Universities, provided that their equivalence has been established by the Association of Indian Universities.*

- b. Verification of documents will be conducted through both online and offline modes. Candidates who are found eligible after the verification process will be permitted to proceed with the admission. Students verified through the online mode are required to submit hard copies of self-attested documents within the stipulated time.
- c. If a candidate submits forged/fake documents, he/she will be liable for legal/criminal proceedings.
- d. CDOE reserves the right to summarily reject any application form scrutinized for any discrepancy and incorrect information before finalizing admission.

7. Post Admission Guidelines

7.1 Identity card

- (i) Identity Card will be issued only to students whose admission is complete in all respects (after due verification & payment of fees). CDOE learners holding CDOE I-Card can use the said ID during counselling sessions and to visit the CDOE Complex only.

- a. In case of loss of Identity Card, the students should file an FIR and submit a copy of the same along with a demand draft of Rs. 200/- in favour of the “Jamia Millia Islamia” payable at “New Delhi” in order to make a request for duplicate Identity Card.
- b. Admission will not be considered complete unless a candidate has a valid identity card issued by CDOE. Admission is liable to be cancelled if a student does not have a valid Identity Card issued by CDOE.
- c. Students are advised to collect the *Programme Guide* for the ensuing academic session from the Office of CDOE or their respective Learner Support Centres. The *Programme Guide* contains the Academic Calendar and other important rules related to counselling, assignments, examinations, and a detailed syllabus.

7.2 Cancellation of Admission and Fee Refund

- (i) In case of cancellation of admission, Programme fee will be refunded as per the following UGC guidelines:

** In case of (1) in the table above, the Higher Educational Institution (HEI) concerned shall deduct an amount not more than 5% of the fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum, of Rs. 5,000/- as processing charges from the refundable amount.*

** Fees shall be refunded by all HEIs to an eligible student within fifteen days from the date of receiving a written application from him/her in this regard.*

- (ii) A candidate would be admitted at a particular Learner Support Centre only if there is a sufficient number of admission seekers in a programme. However, if the number of admission seekers at a Learner Support Centre is inadequate, the following options are available to a student:
 - May be admitted at any other Learner Support Centre, including the

Headquarters, CDOE, where there are sufficient numbers of admission seekers if she/he wishes so

- May change the programme at the same Learner Support Centre, the fees will be adjusted accordingly
- May withdraw admission. In such a case, 100 percent programme fees will be refunded

(iii) A student who has paid programme fee will be given a Roll Number and Enrollment Number, which will also be mentioned in the Identity Card. The Enrolment Number and the Roll Number, thus allotted will continue for the maximum period allowed for the programme or until the programme is completed, whichever is earlier. The Roll Number will change only if one registers afresh for the same programme. The Enrolment Number does not change even if one seeks deferment.

7.3 Change of Optional Subject

A student shall not ordinarily be allowed to change the optional subject(s) of a programme (if any) unless the same is applied for and has been permitted by CDOE. Such applications should be submitted to the Dean, CDOE through respective Program Coordinator. Change in an optional subject(s) is permitted after payment of Rs.1500/- for Self-Learning Material (SLM). The payment should be made through a Demand Draft drawn in favour of Jamia Millia Islamia payable at New Delhi.

7.4 Correction/Change of Name/Surname of Student

Spelling mistakes, if any, committed at the time of the data entry stage will be rectified at the Learner Support Centre and corrected data will be transmitted to the CDOE, for updating in the database. However, students are expected to write their correct name (as indicated in their Class X certificate) in the admission form. In case there is any change in the name (other than the one mentioned in a candidate's Class X certificate), the learner must furnish legal evidence while submitting the admission form.

- (iii) Only English translations of all transcripts, duly attested, will be accepted.
- (iv) Candidates applying from their respective country should get their transcripts attested by the concerned accredited authorized government agency and also duly certified by the Indian Embassy or Consulate.
- (v) For candidates applying from India, all attestation must be done by the concerned Embassy/High Commission/Consulate of the relevant country in India.
- (vi) Applications without the attested documents shall be summarily rejected.

- (viii) Upon arrival in India, every foreign student must register with the Foreigners Regional Registration Office (FRRO) within 14 days from the date of first entry into India as per the prescribed applicable procedure.
- (ix) NRI students will pay the requisite fees through a Demand Draft drawn in favour of Jamia Millia Islamia and payable at New Delhi, for their admission category throughout the duration of the programme even if they may not remain NRIs, i.e. their status changes from NRIs to Non-NRIs.
- (x) All foreign students (old/new) are required to fill out a Registration Form available with the Office of the Foreign Students' Advisor of the University, within 15 days of joining the course. Bonafide certificates shall not be issued if this stipulation is not complied with.
- (xi) The category once filled in the application form shall be final and cannot be changed at any later stage.
- (xii) The admission of foreign diplomats in India wishing to study in the JMI shall be governed by the prescribed applicable procedures and rules as notified by the Government of India from time to time. The fee structure for Foreign/NRI candidates will be applicable to foreign diplomats.


