The Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) 2027 UG syllabus covers five major sections: English Language, Current Affairs including General Knowledge, Legal Reasoning, Logical Reasoning, and Quantitative Techniques. The syllabus assesses candidates on comprehension, reasoning, analytical and numerical skills.
