

CUET UG Eligibility Criteria 2026 for Undergraduate Admissions at Aligarh Muslim University (AMU)

Overview

Admissions to most Undergraduate (UG) courses at **Aligarh Muslim University (AMU)** for the academic session 2026-27 are conducted through the **Common University Entrance Test (CUET UG) 2026**, administered by the National Testing Agency (NTA).

AMU offers approximately 15–20 UG programs via CUET, including B.A. (Hons.), B.Sc. (Hons.), B.Com (Hons.), B.Voc., and others in Arts, Social Sciences, Sciences, Commerce, and Vocational streams.

Note: The official *Guide to Admissions 2026-27* and CUET Supplement are expected to be released soon on www.amucontrollerexams.com. The details below are based on the 2025-26 pattern and reliable sources; eligibility is likely to remain similar (minimum 50% in Class 12).

General Eligibility Criteria

- Passed Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (Class 12) or equivalent from a recognized board.
- Minimum aggregate: **50% marks** in qualifying examination (relaxations for reserved categories as per GoI norms).
- Appearing candidates in Class 12 (2026) are eligible, subject to fulfilling criteria later.
- Age limit: Typically not exceeding 24 years as on July 1, 2026 (varies by course; check official guide).
- Must appear in **CUET UG 2026** with relevant domain subjects mapped to the chosen course.

Important: Exact subject mapping, compulsory subjects in Class 12, and specific relaxations are defined by AMU. Always refer to the official CUET Supplement or Guide to Admissions.

Admission Process

1. Register and appear for **CUET UG 2026** (expected: May 2026).
2. After CUET results, register separately on AMU portal (www.amucontrollerexams.com or counselling portal) – typically June–July 2026.
3. Merit lists (Chance Memo & Selected/Firm Lists) based on CUET scores.
4. Online/offline counselling, document verification, and fee payment.

AMU does **not** publish cut-off marks; selection is purely merit-based via lists.

Key Notes

- Separate applications: One for CUET (NTA) and one for AMU counselling.
- Courses like B.Tech., B.Arch., MBBS/BDS use other exams (JEE/NEET/NATA) – **not CUET**.
- Internal quota and reservations apply as per AMU rules.
