Key Highlights

- **Admission Basis:** Exclusively through CUET (UG) 2026 scores for all regular UG programs (except School of Open Learning, NCWEB, and Foreign Nationals).
- **Release Date:** Official Bulletin released on January 6, 2026 (72 pages).
- **No Major Changes:** Eligibility and subject mapping rules remain the same as previous years.

General Eligibility

- Passed Class XII (Senior Secondary) from a recognized board.
- No minimum percentage required in Class XII to appear in CUET (but Program-Specific Eligibility must be met).
- Gap year candidates are eligible.
- No age limit (except for programs regulated by statutory bodies).

Mandatory CUET Subject Rule (Very Important)

- Candidates **must appear in CUET (UG) 2026 only in subjects studied and passed in Class XII.**
- Even if NTA allows a domain subject not studied in Class 12, **DU will not accept it** for admission.
- For subjects not directly listed (e.g., Biochemistry, Informatics Practices), map to a similar CUET subject with **at least 50% syllabus overlap**. Final decision rests with Delhi University.

Program-Specific Eligibility (PSE)

- Each UG program requires a specific combination of:
 - One Language from List A (minimum 30% in most cases),
 - Domain-Specific Subjects,
 - General Test (where applicable).
- Merit is based solely on CUET scores in the required combination.
- Detailed tables for 190 programs (B.A., B.Com, B.Sc., etc.) are in the official bulletin.

Supernumerary Quotas

- Single Girl Child, Orphans, Armed Forces (CW), ECA, Sports, Kashmiri Migrants, PwBD, Ward Quota, etc.
- Separate guidelines and seat allocation.
