

CUET UG Eligibility Criteria for Jamia Millia Islamia (2026 Admissions)

Important Note

The official prospectus for the 2026-27 academic session has not been released yet (as of January 2026). A notice dated 31-Dec-2025 on the JMI admission portal mentions the “List of Programs Admission through Score of CUET 2026-27”, but the detailed list and eligibility are expected in the full prospectus around March 2026.

The information below is based on the latest available data from the 2025-26 prospectus, CUET guidelines, and reliable sources (Shiksha, PW, TopRankers). Eligibility criteria and program lists are generally consistent year-to-year, but **candidates must verify with the official JMI admission portal (admission.jmi.ac.in or jmi.ac.in) and NTA CUET website (cuet.nta.nic.in) once the 2026 prospectus is released.**

1 General Eligibility Guidelines

- Passed Senior Secondary School Certificate (10+2) or equivalent from a recognized board.
- Appearing candidates (Class 12 in 2026) may apply provisionally; qualifying marks must be submitted by the deadline (typically October 31, 2026).
- Minimum aggregate marks: Generally **50%** (or in the relevant subject); some language programs require **45%**.
- **No mark relaxation** for reserved categories (except 5% for PwD).
- Specific subject requirements in Class 12 for science/vocational programs.
- Admission based solely on **CUET UG 2026 scores**; merit prepared by JMI.
- Correct CUET subject selection is mandatory as per program mapping.

2 UG Programs Offered through CUET UG (Expected for 2026)

JMI typically offers around 15-20 undergraduate programs via CUET. Common programs (based on recent years):

- B.A. (Hons) Hindi, Sanskrit, French & Francophone Studies, Spanish & Latin American Studies, Economics, History, Turkish Language & Literature
- B.Sc. Biotechnology, B.Sc. (Hons) Physics
- B.Voc. (Solar Energy)
- Other B.A. (Hons) in languages and social sciences (exact list to be confirmed)

- Many programs require the specific domain subject or General Test.
- Science programs mandate core subjects (e.g., PCM for Physics).
- Exact mapping for 2026 will be published on NTA CUET and JMI websites.

4 Reservation Policy

- **Muslim Minority:** 30% seats (10% Muslim Women, 10% Muslim OBC/ST).
- **PwD:** 5% horizontal (40% disability; 5% mark relaxation).
- Internal Jamia students, Kashmiri Migrants, NCC/NSS, Sports quotas.

5 Admission Process

1. Register and appear for CUET UG 2026 (NTA).
2. Apply separately on JMI portal with CUET details after results.
3. Merit list based on CUET scores.
4. Document verification and fee payment.
