

Class 10 CBSE Mathematics Deleted Syllabus

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has revised the Class 10 Mathematics syllabus. Certain chapters and topics have been removed to reduce the academic burden. Below is the list of deleted topics for the academic session.

Unit	Deleted Topics/Chapters
Real Numbers	Euclid's Division Lemma
Polynomials	Statement and simple problems on division algorithm for polynomials with real coefficients
Pair of Linear Equations in Two Variables	Cross multiplication method
Quadratic Equations	Situational problems based on equations reducible to quadratic form
Arithmetic Progression	Application in solving daily life problems
Triangles	Proof of the theorem – If a line is drawn parallel to one side of a triangle to intersect the other two sides, then the other two sides are divided in the same ratio. (Proof deleted, application retained)
Coordinate Geometry	No deletion
Trigonometry	Proof of identities of the type $(\sin A + \cos A)^2 = 1 + \sin 2A$ and $(1 + \tan^2 A) = \sec^2 A$
Applications of Trigonometry	Deleted
Circles	Proof of the tangent theorem deleted; Application retained
Constructions	Construction of a triangle similar to a given triangle as per given scale factor
Surface Areas and Volumes	Frustum of a cone
Statistics	Step deviation method for finding mean
Probability	No deletion
