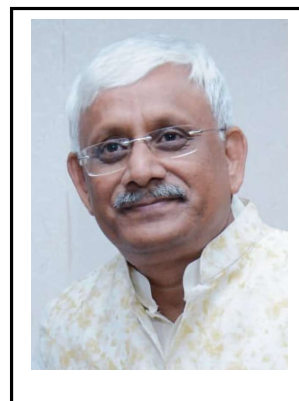

General Instructions

1. The admission to various programmes will be done on the basis of CUET (UG)–2026 score in the relevant mapping subjects and as per the reservation policy of the Government of Madhya Pradesh through the online allotment/counselling process.
2. **The candidate is advised to apply for admission only if he/she fulfils the prescribed eligibility requirements. “The responsibility of ensuring eligibility lies solely with the candidate.”**
3. Candidates whose qualifying exam result is awaited may also register for counselling. Such candidates shall have to produce the final result (in case the result was not declared at the time of counselling/ATKT/Compartment) by **14th August, 2026**, or by the date as notified by the University; otherwise, the admission shall automatically stand cancelled.
4. The name of the candidate must match exactly as recorded in the mark sheet of the qualifying examination issued by the Board. Any discrepancy must be duly certified by the competent authority.
5. In case any Board/Institute does not mention the percentage of marks in the mark sheet/grade sheet, the candidate must produce a certificate from the competent authority stating the equivalent percentage of marks and the conversion formula used, along with the mark sheet/grade sheet at the time of counselling/document verification.
6. The information provided in the online application form shall be verified at the time of document verification/counselling/admission from the original documents. If it is found that a candidate has provided incorrect or false information, concealed relevant facts, or secured admission on the basis of forged certificates/documents, the candidate shall be debarred from admission or the admission shall be cancelled at any stage without prior notice.
7. Seats reserved for SC/ST/OBC-NCL and EWS categories shall be available only to candidates having Madhya Pradesh domicile. SC/ST/OBC-NCL and EWS candidates from other states shall be treated under the Unreserved category. Change of category shall not be permitted at any stage.
8. To avail the benefit of reservation, a valid certificate issued by the competent authority must be produced at the time of document verification/counselling/admission.
9. Conversion of vacant seats among reserved categories (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) shall be carried out in accordance with the directives of the Government of Madhya Pradesh.
10. A candidate admitted under the NRI/NRI-sponsored category/ Foreign Nationals / Person of Indian Origin (PIO) shall not be transferred to any other category unless he/she has duly qualified and fulfils the prescribed eligibility and merit requirements for that category.
11. The number of seats may vary at the time of counselling.
12. The fee structure of various programmes is subject to revision by the University. Any such change shall be applicable to the students admitted for the academic session 2026-2027.

13. Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, Indore, shall use all reasonable endeavours to deliver programmes, duration, and other services in accordance with the descriptions set out in these guidelines. However, the University reserves the right to rename any programme/degree, vary the contents and methods of delivery, discontinue any programme/service, or merge/combine programmes if deemed necessary.
14. All admitted students who are not already enrolled with the University shall be required to complete enrolment as per University rules.
15. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from Universities other than Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, Indore are required to submit an Eligibility certificate issued by Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, Indore after admission.
16. The decision of the University authorities shall be final and binding in all matters relating to admission. The rules may be modified without prior notice, and any such modification shall be binding on all candidates.
17. Any situation not covered under these guidelines shall be referred to the Organizing Committee/Admission Cell, which shall function within the ambit of the Act, Statutes, and Ordinances of Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, Indore, and its decision shall be final.
18. All disputes pertaining to the counselling/admission process of CUET (UG)–2026 and any legal disputes arising thereafter shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Indore only.
19. All information related to document verification/admission/counselling shall be made available on the University website – www.dauniv.ac.in. “No separate communication shall be made”.

7. UTDs may decide to charge the fee on yearly or semester basis.
8. Fee for some programmes which may be subjected to Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee, M.P. shall be applicable as stipulated.
9. As above programmes are Self-Financing in nature, no fee concession shall be available in these programmes.
10. “The fee structure of various programmes is subject to change. Any such changes shall be applicable to the students admitted for the academic session 2026–2027”.

Non-eligibility for Admission

- An applicant who has been convicted by a court of law in India or abroad, or against whom any criminal case is pending before a court, or against whom a challan has been presented, or against whom there are verifiable allegations of misconduct, assault, or misbehaviour with students/officers/employees, or against whom disciplinary action has been taken by concerned School/ Institute/Board of School Education/Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, Indore or any other University, shall not be eligible for admission.
- A full-time government/non-government employee seeking admission to any of the above programmes shall be required to produce a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from his/her employer at the time of admission.

Registration Process

Programs covered under CUET (UG) 2026 are divided into 4 different groups. Candidates who wish to appear in document verification/counseling process must register online for counseling process as per Groups mentioned in Admission Notice. The relevant information of Programmes is mentioned in Table 1 (Page No. 7).

Only the candidates who have appeared in relevant mapping subjects of CUET (UG) - 2026 will be eligible for the registration for groups mentioned in the admission notice.

Candidates who wish to appear in document verification / counseling must register themselves through <https://davv.mponline.gov.in> (Non-refundable Registration Fee Rs. 1500/- + Portal charges Rs. 100/-) through application ID provided at the time of CUET (UG) - 2026 registration.

NOTE: Candidates are advised to study Table No. 1 before proceeding for registration.

Steps for Registration



Merit List

The merit list of registered candidates for the counseling of D.A.V.V., Indore **shall** be prepared on the basis of score secured in relevant mapping subjects of CUET (UG)-2026. Candidate can see their merit on <https://davv.mponline.gov.in>.

In case candidates secure equal aggregate marks, the merit will be determined as under:

For Group B

1. In case two or more candidates secure the same aggregate marks in relevant mapping subjects in CUET (UG)-2026, the candidate obtaining higher marks in the **English** paper of CUET (UG)-2026 shall be ranked higher.
2. If the tie still persists after considering the English paper marks, the candidate obtaining higher marks in the **General Aptitude Test** paper of CUET (UG)-2026 shall be ranked higher.
3. If the tie remains unresolved after the above two criteria, the **system-generated merit order** shall be considered final and binding on all candidates.

For Group C

1. In case two or more candidates secure the same aggregate marks in relevant mapping subjects in CUET (UG)-2026, the candidate obtaining higher marks in the **Mathematics** paper of CUET (UG)-2026 shall be ranked higher.
2. If the tie persists after considering the Mathematics component marks, the candidate obtaining higher marks in the **Physics** paper of CUET (UG)-2026 shall be ranked higher.
3. If the tie still persists, the candidate obtaining higher marks in the **Chemistry** paper of CUET (UG)-2026 shall be ranked higher.
4. If the tie still persists, the candidate obtaining higher marks in the **English** paper of CUET (UG)-2026 shall be ranked higher.
5. If the tie remains unresolved after the above criteria, the **system-generated merit order** shall be final and binding on all candidates.

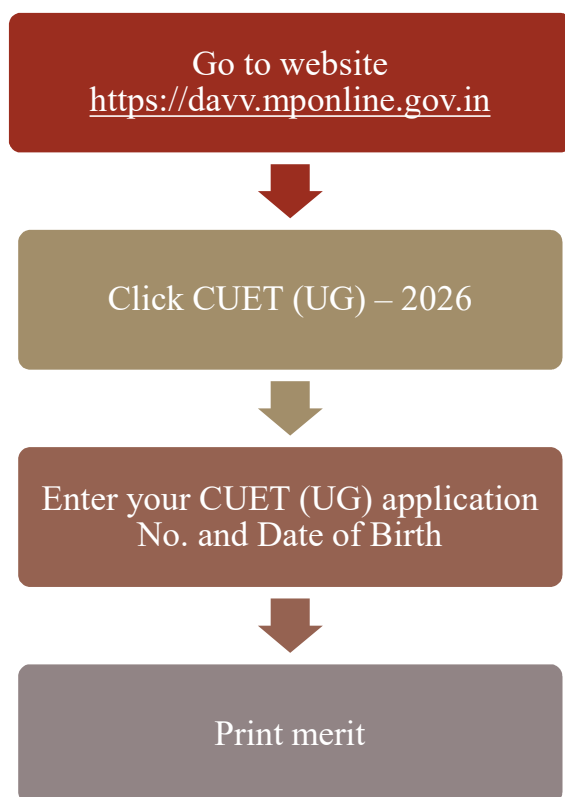
For Group D

1. In case two or more candidates secure the same aggregate marks in relevant mapping subjects in CUET (UG)-2026, the candidate obtaining higher marks in the **Chemistry** paper of CUET (UG)-2026 shall be ranked higher.
2. If the tie persists after considering the Chemistry component marks, the candidate obtaining higher marks in the **Physics** paper of CUET (UG)-2026 shall be ranked higher.
3. If the tie still persists, the candidate obtaining higher marks in the **English** paper of CUET (UG)-2026 shall be ranked higher.
4. If the tie remains unresolved after the above criteria, the **system-generated merit order** shall be final and binding on all candidates.

For Group E

1. In case two or more candidates secure the same aggregate marks in relevant mapping subjects in CUET (UG)-2026, the candidate obtaining higher marks in the **Biology** paper of CUET (UG)-2026 shall be ranked higher.
2. If the tie persists after considering the Biology component marks, the candidate obtaining higher marks in the **Chemistry** paper of CUET (UG)-2026 shall be ranked higher.
3. If the tie still persists, the candidate obtaining higher marks in the **Physics** paper of CUET (UG)-2026 shall be ranked higher.
4. If the tie still persists, the candidate obtaining higher marks in the **English** paper of CUET (UG)-2026 shall be ranked higher.
5. If the tie remains unresolved after the above criteria, the system-generated merit order shall be final and binding on all candidates.

Steps to view the merit list



Note:

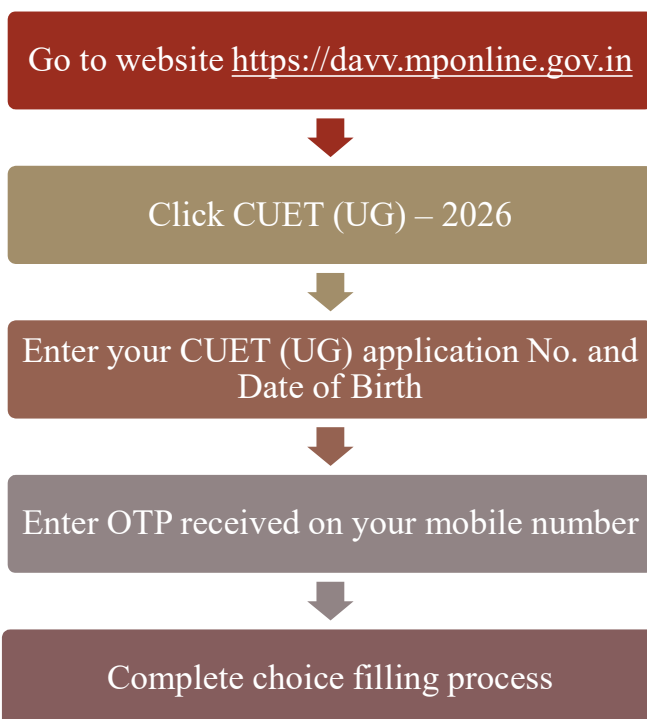
1. Separate merit list will be generated for each group and each round of counseling
2. Similarly, separate merit will be generated for different categories such as UR, ST, SC, OBC-NCL, EWS, JKR, JKM, PWD, EW.

Choice filling for first round of Counselling

During the choice filling process, students may select all the programmes offered within their eligible group in order of priority. For example, if a student is eligible for admission under Group B, he/she can

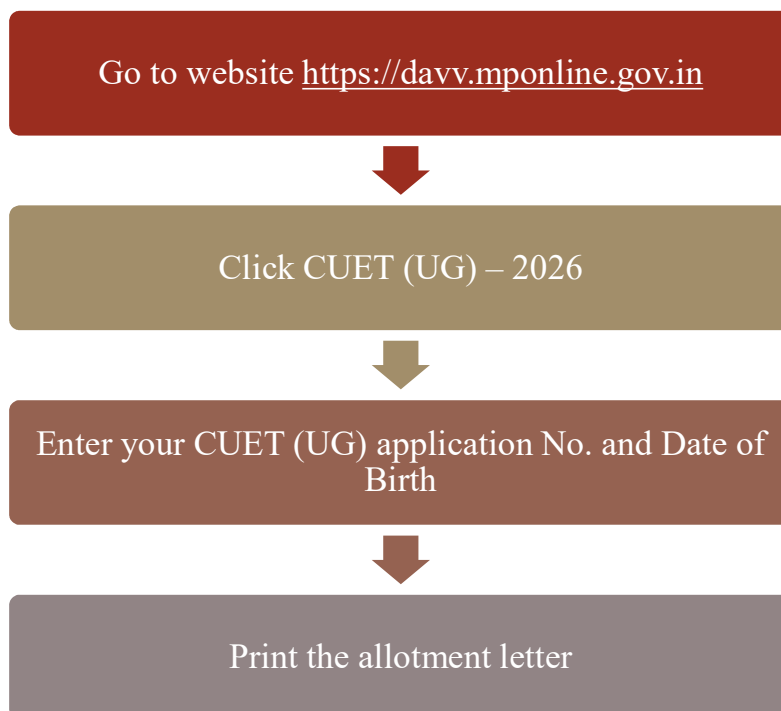
opt for all 19 programmes available in that group. The allotment of programmes will be based on the priority order submitted during choice filling, along with the merit list.

Group D and E: In these groups, only one programme is available. However, students are still required to complete the choice filling process.



Allotment of the programme for First Counseling

Allotment of the programmes for different groups will be done as per the merit generated on aggregate score in relevant mapping subjects of CUET (UG)-2026.



First Counseling

1. For first counselling and document verification process, schedule will be notified on the University web site www.dauniv.ac.in after the Allotment of the programme for First Counseling.
2. For further rounds of counseling visit University web site www.dauniv.ac.in regularly.

Reservation rules

General: These rules shall be known as the *Rules for Admission to various Certificate, Diploma, Undergraduate, Integrated, PG Diploma, and Postgraduate programs* of Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, Indore, conducted through the Common University Entrance Test [CUET (UG)], scores of entrance tests conducted by the respective School/Institute/Department, or on the basis of merit determined by the percentage of marks obtained in the qualifying examination.

1. **Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) Category of Madhya Pradesh:** 16% and 20% of the sanctioned intake are reserved for candidates belonging to the SC and ST categories of Madhya Pradesh, respectively. Candidates must produce a certificate from the competent authority in *Proforma-1*, as provided in this rule book at the time of document verification/counseling (Vide MP Government GAD Order No. F.7-2/96 अ.प्र./1, Bhopal, dated 01.08.1996, and as per the latest orders issued by the Government of Madhya Pradesh) The benefit of reservation shall be available only to domiciles of Madhya Pradesh.
2. **OBC Category (Non-Creamy Layer) of Madhya Pradesh:** 14% of the sanctioned intake is reserved for candidates belonging to the OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) category of Madhya Pradesh. Candidates must produce a certificate from the competent authority in *Proforma-2*, as provided in this rule book. (Vide MP Government GAD Order No. F/7-2/96 अ.प्र./1, Bhopal, dated 12.03.1997, and Order No. F-7-2/96 अ.प्र./1, Bhopal, dated 06.07.2000, and as per the latest orders issued by the Government of Madhya Pradesh regarding the creamy layer) Candidates must also produce a valid income certificate issued by the competent authority at the time of document verification/counseling, indicating their family's income. The benefit of reservation shall be available only to domiciles of Madhya Pradesh.
3. **Reservation for Economical Weaker Section (EWS) candidates of Madhya Pradesh:** 10% seats, over and above the approved intake, shall be available for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates. As per the Government of Madhya Pradesh GAD Letter No. एफ-07-11/2019/अ.प्र./एफ, Bhopal, dated 02 July 2019, ten percent (10%) seats of the approved intake shall be available for admission to EWS candidates of Madhya Pradesh. These seats shall be available only to Madhya Pradesh domicile candidates whose family's annual income from all sources does not exceed ₹8.00 lakh (Rupees Eight Lakh only). A candidate claiming an EWS seat must produce a certificate from the competent authority in *Proforma-3*, as provided in this rule book at the time of document verification/counseling.

4. **Reservation for Female Candidates:** 30% of seats in each category, viz. UR, SC, ST, and OBC-NCL, shall be reserved for female candidates. This reservation shall be treated as a compartmentalized horizontal reservation. Seats remaining vacant in the female quota of a category shall be filled by converting such seats into the Open Quota (OP) of the same category. However, if, even after such conversion, the Open Quota (OP) of that category remains unfilled, the vacancies shall be filled by converting them into the Open Quota (OP) of other categories, as per the norms.
5. **Reservation for Persons with disabilities (PWD):** 5% of seats in each category, viz. UR, SC, ST, and OBC, shall be reserved for candidates with a disability of 40% or more, subject to Madhya Pradesh domicile requirements. This reservation shall be treated as a compartmentalized horizontal reservation. Seats remaining vacant in this quota shall be filled by converting such seats into the Open Quota (OP) of the same category. However, if, even after such conversion, the Open Quota (OP) of that category remains unfilled, the vacancies shall be filled by converting them into the Open Quota (OP) of other categories, as per the prescribed procedure.
6. **Reservation for NCC “C” Certificate Candidates:** 1% of the sanctioned intake at the postgraduate level shall be reserved for candidates who are NCC ‘C’ Certificate holders from a college/institute/university in Madhya Pradesh.
7. **J & K Migrant’s Seats:** One seat, on a supernumerary (over and above) basis, in each program shall be reserved for J&K migrants. The candidate must produce a certificate, as given in *Proforma-4*, duly signed by the competent authority at the time of document verification.
- Sons/daughters of employees of the Government of Madhya Pradesh who have served in the State of Jammu & Kashmir for curbing insurgency shall also be eligible under the J & K Migrant category.**
- Such candidates must have passed their qualifying examination from the State of Jammu & Kashmir.
- Candidates must produce a certificate in *Proforma-5* of this rule book at the time of document verification.
8. **J & K Resident’s Seats:** One seat, on a supernumerary (over and above) basis, in each program shall be reserved for residents of Jammu & Kashmir. The candidate must produce a certificate duly signed by the competent authority at the time of document verification.
9. **DAVV Employee ward quota:** Admission for wards of University employees shall be carried out in accordance with University guidelines. Such admissions shall be over and above the total number of seats available in the concerned program (*Proforma-6*)
- (“Ward” shall mean the husband, wife, son, or daughter of an employee/teacher/officer. In this regard, a certificate from the Registrar, Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, Indore, or the competent authority of the University shall be required.)
- Note:** These seats are interchangeable, and can be converted to other category (Officer/Teacher to Employee or Vice -Versa) if they remain vacant.

Eligibility and Other Details for NRI / NRI Sponsored / Foreign Nationals / Persons of Indian Origin (PIO)

NRI / NRI Sponsored:

- 1. NRI / NRI Sponsored: 5% of the total sanctioned intake shall be reserved for Non-Resident Indian (NRI) candidates.** Admission to these seats shall be conducted strictly in accordance with the “*Admission (Reservation to Non-Resident Indian) Regulations, 2011,*” published in the MP Government Gazette on May 19, 2011.

Eligibility: Candidates must be NRIs, Overseas Citizens of India (OCI), Persons of Indian Origin (PIO), or children/wards/first-degree relatives of NRIs.

Admission Process: Candidates seeking admission under this category shall be eligible without appearing for an entrance test. Admission shall be based on marks obtained in the qualifying examination.

Seat Conversion: If NRI seats remain vacant, they shall be converted into the general pool.

Foreign Nationals / Person of Indian Origin (PIO):

- 1. Foreign Nationals:** Citizens of all countries who are not of Indian origin, as defined under PIO. A foreign student, in this context, shall mean a student who possesses a foreign passport.
- 2. “PIO” means Persons of Indian Origin:** PIOs are persons who are citizens of other countries (except Pakistan and Bangladesh) and who, at any time, have held an Indian passport, or whose parents or grandparents were citizens of India by virtue of the provisions of the Constitution of India or Section 2(b) of the Citizenship Act, 1955 (Act No. 57 of 1955).

15% of seats in each program shall be reserved for Foreign Nationals/PIOs on a supernumerary (over and above) basis.

Candidates seeking admission under this category shall be eligible without appearing for an entrance test. Such candidates must fulfil the eligibility requirements of the concerned program with at least **45% aggregate marks** in the qualifying examination.

The **Last date for submission of applications** from Foreign Nationals/PIO/NRI/NRI sponsored candidates for counselling registration (Non-refundable Registration fee Rs. 5000/- + Portal Charges Rs. 100/-) through <https://davv.mponline.gov.in> is **14.07.2026**.

Registration for NRI / NRI Sponsored / Foreign Nationals / PIO Candidates:

- 1. Such candidates should apply through web site <https://davv.mponline.gov.in> by 14.07.2026 and submit documents with application form to the “Chairman, Admission Cell, International Institute of Professional Studies (IIPS), Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, Takshashila Campus, Khandwa Road, Indore, M. P. - 452001” by 18.07.2026.** Any change in the date will be notified on the website.
