1. PREAMBLE

The Gujarat University is established in the year 1949 by The Gujarat University Act, 1949. As per the powers conferred under section 4 read with section 22 of the Gujarat Public Universities Act, 2023, the Gujarat University has framed “The Gujarat University Three Years’ LL.B. Programme Admission Rules, 2026”. The mission of the on-line Centralized Admission through GCAS Portal by the Education Department of the Government of Gujarat is to carry out admission in every stream at all 14 statutory Universities of the Gujarat State in a fair and transparent manner for the academic year 2026-27. The admission process is conducted strictly on the basis of merit and the preference of the candidate and as per the instructions given by the Education Department, Government of Gujarat from time to time on GCAS Portal.



2. ADMISSION RULES

The Gujarat University Three Years' LL.B. Programme Admission Rules, 2026

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 4 read with section 22 of the Gujarat Public Universities Act, 2023 the Gujarat University hereby makes the following rules to regulate On Line Centralized Admission of Three Years' LL.B. Programme mentioned hereinafter -

1. Short Title and Commencement

- 1.1. These rules may be called the “The Gujarat University Three Years' LL.B. Programme Admission Rules, 2026”.
- 1.2. These rules shall be applicable for centralized admission for the academic year 2026-27 only in the LL.B. Semester – I of Three Years' LL.B. Programme for the Law Colleges offering Three Years' LL.B. Programme affiliated with the Gujarat University. However, in the event of inconsistency between these rules and the instructions issued by the Education Department, Government of Gujarat / authorized person on its behalf, the later shall prevail.
- 1.3. The Gujarat University Three Years' LL.B. Programme Admission Rules, 2026 shall come into force from June, 15, 2026 and all the earlier ordinances, rules and regulations if any, made for the purpose of admission repugnant or contrary to these rules shall be considered as null and void for the Three Years' LL.B. Admission Programme of the Year 2026-27.-

2. Definitions

- 2.1. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,-
 - 2.1.1. “University” means the Gujarat University listed in the Schedule under the Gujarat Public Universities Act, 2023;
 - 2.1.2. “UGC” means University Grants Commission constituted under the University Grants Commission Act, 1956;
 - 2.1.3. “Bar Council of India” means the Bar Council of India constituted under Section 4 of the Advocates Act, 1961.
 - 2.1.4. “Centers of Legal Education” means – Department of Law of the Gujarat University, all Law Colleges offering Three Years' LL.B. Programme affiliated with the Gujarat University recognized and approved by the BCI offering Three Years' LL.B. Programme.



- 2.1.5. “Rules” means “The Gujarat University Three Years’ LL.B. Programme Admission Rules, 2026”;
- 2.1.6. “Admission Committee” means “Gujarat University Admission Committee” framed for centralized online admission of Gujarat University for programs mentioned in 1.2 ;
- 2.1.7. “admission” for the purpose of these rules means on-line admission of candidates in the program mentioned in 1.2;
- 2.1.8. “Gujarat Board” means the Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary School Examination Board established under section 3 of the Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary School Board Act, 1972 (Guj.18 of 1973);
- 2.1.9. “school” means a higher secondary school (XII, 10+2 pattern);
- 2.1.10. “university school” means a “university school” as defined in the Gujarat Public Universities Act, 2023;
- 2.1.11. “department” means a “university department” as defined in the Gujarat Public Universities Act, 2023;
- 2.1.12. “college” or “institution” means a “university college”, “degree college”, “constituent college”, “affiliated college”, “Government College” or “college” as defined in the Gujarat Public Universities Act, 2023;
- 2.1.13. “Help Centers” means the Centers notified and approved by GCAS by the Admission Committee for facilitation of the candidate for online admission process at 3 years’ LL.B. Programme;
- 2.1.14. “The Gujarat University Three Years’ LL.B. Programme” means Three Years’ LL.B. Programme approved by the Bar Council of India as well as the Gujarat University ;
- 2.1.15. “merit marks” or “percentage of marks” means the total marks obtained by the candidate in his/her obtained marks in the theory and/or practical subjects of Last two Semesters (or Last Year) of the graduation examination;
- 2.1.16. “qualifying examination” means the final year examination (examination of last two semesters) of graduation degree programme in any other graduation examination taken by the university recognized by the UGC as well as the Bar Council of India;
- 2.1.17. “website” means the official website of the Admission Committee to carry out online admission process;
- 2.1.18. “Bar Council of India – Rules of Legal Education - 2008” (amended in the



year 2015) means Rules on standards of legal education and recognition of degrees in law for the purpose of enrolment as advocate and inspection of Universities for recognizing its degree in law under sections 7(1)(h) and (i), 24(1)(c)(iii) and 49(1)(af), (ag) and (d) of the Advocates Act, 1961 made by the Bar Council of India in consultation with Universities and State Bar Councils ;

2.1.19. “unaided” means self-financed (Higher Payment) ;

2.1.20. “PI” means participating institution – Law Colleges;

2.2. The words and expressions used in these rules but not defined shall have the same meanings as assigned to them in the Rules.

4. Admission to Three Years’ LL.B. Programme :

Admission to the Semester - I of the program mentioned in 1.2 shall be given on all the government, grant-in-aid and Higher Payment (Self financed –unaided) seats on the basis of merit list prepared by the Gujarat University and GCAS taking into consideration the mandatory requirements of Bar Council of India with regard to commencement of the teaching process. The admission process will commence as per the Instructions given by GCAS.

5. Seats Available for Centralized Admission :

For the purpose of centralized admission to the Semester - I of the program, available seats shall include seats of all the Centers of Legal Educations affiliated with the Gujarat University excluding upto 25 % Management Quota Seats of each Centre of Legal Education offering various Three Years’ LL.B. Programs sanctioned and approved by the



Bar Council of India, State Government and the Gujarat University. However, it will be permissible for the concerned Centre of Legal Education to waive or reduce its management quota.;

6. Eligibility for Admission :

- 6.1. In order to apply for admission at Three Years' LL.B. Programme, a candidate must have passed the qualifying Graduation Degree Examination recognized by the UGC, Association of Indian Universities (AIU) as well as BCI.
- 6.2. A candidate who has passed the qualifying examination with minimum 45 % of marks or equivalent grade (Both at the aggregate in graduation and in last two semesters of qualifying examination) shall be eligible for admission. The candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribes (ST) will be given relaxation of 5 % from the above criteria. (Minimum 40% for the candidates of SC and ST categories) and the candidates belonging to SEBC category will be given relaxation of 3 % (Minimum 42 % for the candidates of SEBC Category);

Provided that such a minimum qualifying marks shall not automatically entitle a candidate to get admission in any of the Center of Legal Education affiliated with the Gujarat University but shall only entitle the candidate concerned to fulfill basic criteria fixed by the Bar Council of India or other equivalent authority, State Government, GCAS as well as the Gujarat University from time to time to apply for the admission..

- 6.3 A candidate who has passed the last examination from other than Gujarat University have to obtain On Line Provisional Eligibility Certificate (PEC) from the Gujarat University.

6.3.1 The candidates who have passed the last examination from any University situated out of the State of Gujarat are required to obtain On Line Provisional Eligibility Certificate (PEC) from the Gujarat University before on-line applying for admission.

6.3.2 However, the candidates who have passed last examination from any university other than the Gujarat University, situated within the State of Gujarat are required to take Online Provisional Eligibility Certificate (PEC) from the Gujarat University only after securing admission in any of the law Colleges affiliated with the Gujarat University in the first term itself.

If a candidate has not passed Graduation Examination or qualifying graduation/equivalent examination from any University not recognized by the UGC, the Gujarat University shall have all the rights to refuse to grant Provisional Eligibility Certificate (PEC) and admission of such candidate, if granted by any college shall automatically stand cancelled.

Candidate, who has passed graduation/ equivalent examination from any Foreign University has to obtain "Equivalence Certificate" from Association of Indian Universities" (AIU) and thereafter apply for 'Provisional Eligibility Certificate' at the Gujarat University.

The candidates who have taken admission and/or passed any other academic programme from the Gujarat University after having passed Qualifying Examination (Graduation) from other University need not have to obtain Provisional Eligibility Certificate (PEC). But such candidates shall be considered within the category of "Other University" for seeking admission at the Three Years' LL.B. Admission.



In the same manner, the candidate who have passed the qualifying examination from the Gujarat University and thereafter pursued any other programme from other University are required to obtain Online Provisional Eligibility Certificate (PEC) in any of the aforesaid manner mentioned hereinabove. However, such candidates will be considered within the category of “Gujarat University” students.

- 6.4 No student shall be allowed to simultaneously register for a law degree programme with any other graduate or postgraduate or professional course run by the same or any other University or an Institute for academic or professional learning excepting in the Three Years’ Law Degree Programme of the Gujarat University or any other University or Professional Institute Courses.
- 6.5 As per the provisions of the Bar Council of India, no student shall be permitted to engage into employment, service or do any business during the teaching hours of the Center of Legal Education.
- 6.6 As laid down in the Bar Council of India – Legal Education Rules, 2008 (Amended in the year 2015), the maximum age for seeking admission shall be 30 years as on 15.06.2025. However, in case of applicants from SC and ST categories the maximum age limit for seeking admission shall be 35 years as on 15.06.2025. As per the interim order of the Supreme Court, any candidate exceeding above age may apply and take conditional admission on furnishing undertaking at the concerned Center of Legal Education to the effect that his/her admission will be subject to the approval of the Bar Council of India as well as final decision of the Supreme Court. (see page 22 herein)
- 6.7 No candidate shall be permitted to fill in the form after the cut-off date declared by the GCAS from time to time. for applying for Three Years’ LL.B. Semester – I Programme is over. If the result of the candidate is not declared or withheld by the University due to any reason till the cut-off date of making on line application, the candidate shall not be eligible to apply on line at the above mentioned programme.

7 Reservation of Seats as per the Gujarat University Ordinances, Notification of the State Government and order of the Hon’ble High Court of Gujarat :

- 7.1 For the purpose of admission, the seats shall be reserved for the candidates who are of Gujarat origin having Category Certificates issued by the Competent authority of the Government of Gujarat and falling under the following categories and in following proportion, namely-
- 7.2
 - 7.2.1 Scheduled Castes (SC) : 7%
 - 7.2.2 Scheduled Tribes (ST) : 15%
 - 7.2.3 Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC) : 27%
 - 7.2.4 Economically Weaker Section (EWS) (As per BCI Circular) : 10% (within this quota 33 % reservation for Women)
 - 7.2.5 Candidates who have passed Qualifying Examination from Universities other than the Gujarat University : 5 %
 - 7.2.6 Management Seats (if any) for each Centre of Legal Education : 25 % (Maximum)
 - 7.2.7 Physically Handicapped : 5 % among all categories
- 7.3 A candidate seeking admission on reserved seat shall be originally belong to the State of Gujarat and required to upload Certificate of Caste issued by the Competent Authority of the State of Gujarat.
Provided that the candidate belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward



Classes (SEBC) shall be required to upload Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of the Government of Gujarat stating that non-inclusion of candidate in Creamy Layer in addition to the caste certificate. **Such Non-Creamy Layer Certificate shall be valid for the period of 3 years from the date of issuance of such certificate by the Competent Authority of the Government of Gujarat or any such other period as notified by the Competent Authority from time to time.** No caste certificate/ Non-creamy Layer Certificate shall be valid unless it is duly stamped, signed and issued by the competent authority empowered by the Government of Gujarat and produced/uploaded its original copy.

A candidate belonging to Economically Weaker Section (EWS) has to upload the Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of the State of Gujarat stating that the candidate belongs to the category of Economically Weaker Section (EWS). Such EWS Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of the Government of Gujarat shall be valid only for the current financial year (2026-27) or as may be notified by the Competent Authority from time to time.

- 7.4 No certificate to the effect of non-inclusion in Creamy Layer/EWS category shall be valid, unless it is duly stamped, signed and issued by the authority empowered by the Government of Gujarat. Such certificate shall be valid for the period of 3 years from the date of issuance thereof by the Competent Authority or as notified by the Government of Gujarat and produced/uploaded its original copy.
- 7.5 If a candidate fails to upload relevant Category (SC/ST/SEBC/EWS/Phy.Handi. / Non-Creamy Layer) Certificates as required within the stipulated time, his/her candidature shall be considered for admission under unreserved-General category. No dispute regarding the aforesaid matter shall be entertained thereafter.
- 7.6 If a candidate of reserved category gets admission on unreserved seat in the order of merits, he/she may be given admission on the unreserved seat according to his/her preference and merit.
- 7.7 The admission of a candidate of a reserved category on a reserved seat shall be valid subject to the verification of caste certificate issued by the Competent Authority empowered by the State Government in this behalf. In case the caste certificate is found invalid on verification, he/she shall not have right to claim his/her admission on reserved seat and if he/she has already been granted admission, such admission shall be cancelled. Admission of such candidate may be continued in case of availability of vacant unreserved seats, subject to the condition of eligibility of merit.
- 7.8 After allotting admission to all the candidates of reserved categories on respective reserved seats, the vacant reserved category seats of Scheduled Caste (SC) (if any) shall be transferred to the seats of Scheduled Tribes (ST) and similarly, the vacant reserved category seats of Scheduled Tribe(ST) shall be transferred to the seats of Scheduled Caste (SC) by the Admission Committee after having obtained sanction from the competent authority of the GCAS.
- 7.9 After having allotted admissions to all the candidates as mentioned in 7.7 above, the remaining reserved category vacant seats (if any) shall be transferred to the seats of General Category from second round of admission by the Admission Committee after having obtained sanction from the competent authority of the GCAS.

8 Reservation For Physically Disabled Candidates :

5 % (Five percent) of all the available seats among all categories shall be reserved, in accordance with the provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, for the persons with disability who can perform the academic activities in the respective



program. A candidate with disability shall have to upload copy of original certificate of disability issued and duly signed by the Civil Surgeon and produce before college for verification while taking admission after allotment.

After having allotted the PH seats to all eligible PH category candidates, the remaining seats (if any) will be transferred to the respective categories.

Explanation: “person with disability” means a person suffering from **not less than 40 % (forty per cent)** of any disability as certified by a competent medical authority.

9 General Rules for the Programme :

- 9.1 A candidate must abide by the Rules and Regulations of the State of Gujarat, GCAS, UGC, Gujarat University, Bar Council of India, other competent authorities and the concerned Center of Legal Education.
- 9.2 The medium of instruction of the programme shall be in English as well as Gujarati. The Examination will also be engaged in both the above languages.
- 9.3 Three Years’ LL.B. Programme offered by the Gujarat University is a full time programme. No candidate shall be permitted to simultaneously pursue other Graduation or Post Graduation/ other Programme run by the Gujarat University or any other University or any courses run by the Professional Institutions. As per the provisions of the Bar Council of India, the candidate will not be permitted to serve or do business and/or engage into employment during the teaching hours of the Center of Legal Education.
- 9.4 After having obtained admission in any of the Center of Legal Education, if a candidate is caught indulging in ragging, his/her admission will be cancelled by the Center of Legal Education and the Fees will not be refunded. The guilty candidate shall also be responsible for all the consequences arising out of ragging activities.
- 9.5 Every candidate has to complete the internship as prescribed in the Bar Council of India – Rules of Legal Education, 2008 (amended Rules of the year 2015) during his/her study at the Three Years’ LL.B. Programme.
- 9.6 Minimum 75 % attendance of the candidate must be required during each term of Three Years’ LL.B. Programme.
- 9.7 Three Years’ LL.B. Programme is a Full Time Programme offered by the Gujarat University as per the Bar Council of India – Legal Education Rules, 2008 and the **candidates are not permitted to pursue other studies/to serve or to do any business or engage into employment during the study which is in direct conflict with the teaching hours of the programme** i.e. for morning college 7.30 am to 1.30 pm, for noon college 10.00 am to 4.00 pm and for after-noon colleges 1.00 pm to 7.00 pm.
- 9.8 In case a candidate has taken admission by way of misrepresentation, concealment of material facts or fraud and after having cleared Three Years’ LL.B. Programme successfully, if the Bar Council of Gujarat, in future on the above grounds or similar grounds refuses or denies to grant Sanad to the candidate on any of the above grounds or similar grounds, the Center of Legal Education or the Gujarat University or GCAS shall not be responsible and such candidate shall not claim any equity/legal right and if at all the degree of law is issued by the Gujarat University after having obtained such admission in any of the affiliated law colleges of the Gujarat University by way of misrepresentation, concealment or fraud, the same shall stand cancelled forthwith. If any matter related to any such admission comes to the notice of the Admission Committee, the Gujarat University or any other competent authority after scrutiny, such admission shall be cancelled forthwith by the Center of Legal Education.



- 9.9 **Before applying or securing admission at any of the colleges offering Three Years' LL.B. Programme, the student must verify as to whether the particular college- Centre for Legal Education is approved/recognized by the Bar Council of India or not for the academic year 2025-26. The information regarding status of approval of the concerned Center of Legal Education can be verified from the official website of the Bar Council of India and the same will be listed and updated by the GCAS at the portal from time to time. In future, if the Bar Council of India/ State Bar Council refuses to grant Sanad to any candidate who has pursued legal education from any college- Centre for Legal Education which is not approved/recognized by the BCI, the GCAS or the Gujarat University shall not be liable in any circumstances.**
- 9.10 Any ordinance, rules, regulations or circulars of the Gujarat University passed earlier regarding admission at the Three Years' LL.B. Programme contrary to these Rules shall be considered as null and void.

10 Distribution of Seats among Candidates :

For the purpose of admission, the available seats shall be distributed based on the merit list prepared in 12.1:

- 10.1 95 % of available seats for the admission shall be distributed among the candidates who have passed qualifying examination from the Gujarat University and 5% seats of available seats for admission shall be reserved for candidate who has passed qualifying examination from any University other than the Gujarat University. The above seat distribution shall be made by maintaining reservation criteria as notified by the State Government and the Gujarat University from time to time.
- 10.2 **The candidates who have passed qualifying examination from any University other than the Gujarat University and have obtained Grade/CGPA/Credits in their mark-sheets shall have to upload Equivalent Percentage Certificate of qualifying examination issued from the competent authority of the concerned University while making on line application at GCAS Portal otherwise the application of such candidates shall not be included in the merit list.**

11 Supernumerary Seats:

There shall not be any supernumerary seats other than the sanctioned seats to each Centre of Legal Education by the Bar Council of India as the same is not permissible under the Bar Council of India – Rules of Legal Education, 2008 (amended Rules of the year 2015). However, as per the letter of the BCI, 10 % supernumerary seats shall be kept for the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) category students, out of which 33 % seats shall be reserved for women.

12 Preparation of Merit List :

The merit list of the candidates who have duly made on line application for admission in the manner prescribed by the GCAS, within the prescribed time limit and who are found eligible for admission under these rules, shall be prepared in the following manner, namely-

- 12.1 For the candidates who have passed the qualifying graduation examination, aggregate marks of last year or last two semesters obtained in graduation examination i.e. qualifying examination;
- 12.2 The criteria for deciding merit order in case of candidates having equal merit marks shall be based on the following descending sequence, namely-
- 12.2.1 Aggregate marks of second last year or two semesters of second last year obtained in qualifying examination;



12.2.2 Aggregate marks of third last year or two semesters of third last year obtained in qualifying examination;

12.2.3 Aggregate marks of HSC Examination or equivalent examination;

12.2.4 Aggregate marks of SSC Examination or equivalent examination;

13 On line Registration for Admission :

13.1 The student has to make registration from the Gujarat Common Admission Services i.e. **GCAS Portal** of Education Department of the Government of Gujarat or **log on to on line Registration link** www.gcas.gujgov.edu.in. The Government of Gujarat as well as all statutory Universities of the Gujarat State including the Gujarat University shall, by advertisement in the prominent newspapers widely circulated in the university area or by web-site or through GCAS Portal or by such other means, as it may consider convenient, publish Admission Schedule i.e. the date of registration, last date for submission of registration form, programs offered and such other information as may be necessary in this behalf. In order to get admission in any of the affiliated law colleges offering Three Years' LL.B. Programme at the Gujarat University, the students must invariably make registration and fill in the required form only through GCAS Portal.

13.2 A candidate seeking admission shall apply on-line, for the registration of his/her candidature, only through the link given by the Education Department, Government of Gujarat through GCAS portal. **It will be permissible for the candidate to apply through above GCAS portal to more than one University and different colleges as well as different programmes at different Universities.**

13.3 **For the purpose of registration, a candidate shall be required to make on line Registration through GCAS Portal or on the link: www.gcas.gujgov.edu.in by on line payment of Registration Fees as fixed by GCAS.**

13.4 **After payment of Registration Fees, the candidates have to complete entire registration process such as providing on line personal information, academic information, selection of programme and University, choice and preference of the colleges etc. The candidates are required to upload his/her passport size photograph, signature, marksheets and caste/category certificates on line as per the instructions given in GCAS Portal. Candidates have to carefully upload the aforesaid documents as there is no verification process before offering admission. Thereafter it will be permissible for the candidate to select the Centers of Legal Education (Law Colleges) from various statutory Universities and give preference as well.**

13.5 **The candidates who have passed qualifying examination from any University other than the Gujarat University and have obtained Grade/CGPA/Credits in their mark-sheets shall have to upload alongwith their marksheets, Equivalent Percentage Certificate issued from the competent authority(with its sign and seal) of the concerned Board while making on line application and verification of Marks; otherwise the application of such candidates shall not be included in the merit list.**

14 Admission Procedure

The admission procedure shall be done as per the instructions of GCAS authorities from time to time. The students are requested to see the instructions on GCAS portal for admission process.

15 Fee :

A candidate who is offered admission through centralized admission process at any Centre of Legal Education shall have to pay entire fees at the Centre of Legal Education



where admission is offered, within stipulated time. On failure of payment of fees within the stipulated time given by the GCAS, the student will not be eligible to get admission at the concerned Center of Legal Education (Law College) wherein he/she is offered admission.

16 Documents to be Attached with the application where admission is offered :

16.1 The candidate shall, at the Center of Legal Education where admission is offered, submit the self-attested copies of the following documents along with the print out of the registration form while taking final admission. If required the admission committee may verify the documents which are uploaded with admission application. Candidate must bring all necessary Original documents/Mark sheets for the purpose of verification.

- 16.1.1 SSC Examination (Std. X) Mark-sheet.
- 16.1.2 HSC Examination (Std. XII) Mark-sheet.
- 16.1.3 Mark-sheets of last three years or last six semesters of Graduation Examination.
- 16.1.4 School Leaving Certificate
- 16.1.5 Copy of Aadhar Card
- 16.1.6 Copy of On line Provisional Eligibility Certificate (PEC) to be issued by the Gujarat University for the candidates who have passed Qualifying Examination from any University other than Gujarat University
- 16.1.7 Caste certificate for a candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST) and Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC), issued by the authority empowered by the Gujarat State Government in this behalf.
- 16.1.8 Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) certificate of the family, by the candidate of SEBC Category issued by competent authority empowered by the State of Gujarat in this behalf. **Such Non-Creamy Layer Certificate shall be valid for the period of 3 years from the date of issuance thereof by the Competent Authority of the State of Gujarat or as may be notified by the State Government time to time.**
- 16.1.9 EWS Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of the State of Gujarat.
- 16.1.10 Certificate of Physical Disability, issued and duly signed by the Civil Surgeon/ competent Medical Authority, in case of a Physically Handicapped candidate.
- 16.1.11 Such other certificates as the Admission Committee deems necessary.

Note : While submitting the copies of the documents, a candidate must have Original Documents with him/her for the purpose of verification. No original documents are required to be deposited at the college. However, the students are advised to go through the instructions uploaded at GCAS portal.

16.2 After getting the allotment offer letter, the candidate shall have to produce for verification, all the original certificates and testimonials which are necessary, at the



PG Center/Department of Law only, within time-limit as may be specified in the Admission Offer Letter by the GCAS.

- 16.3 The candidate who is unable to produce original certificates and testimonials necessary for the purpose of registration/admission within the time-limit prescribed with the Admission Offer Letter of GCAS, then such admission shall automatically be cancelled ;
- 16.4 In the event of failure to submit original certificates and testimonials within the time limit as aforesaid, the provisional admission offer shall be cancelled.

17 Ineligibility for admission on production of false documents :

At any point of time the admission committee can verify the uploaded documents, During verification of documents or subsequently, if the GCAS, Admission Committee, University and/or allotted Centers of Legal Education finds any certificate or testimonial or information submitted by any candidate, incorrect or false, the candidature of such candidate shall be cancelled for that year and he/she shall be disqualified for admission at the Gujarat University for the period of next two years.

18 Vacant Seats :

After offering admission to all the candidates whose name appear in the merit list or after completion of second Round of the admission process, if the seats remain vacant, such vacant seats shall be filled in as per the Instructions given at GCAS Portal by the Education Department, Government of Gujarat/ any authorized officer to the Gujarat University.

19 Seat Matrix

Every institute shall be required to submit detailed Seat Matrix and number of seats as sanctioned by the Bar Council of India for the academic year 2026-27 referring to distribution as mentioned in 7.1 within stipulated time period as specified by the GCAS.

20 Penalty :

Any breach of any of the provisions of the Ordinances/Rules of the Gujarat University, Bar Council of India or Rules or any directions issued, by the Admission Committee time to time, by any person shall be liable to penalty which shall be decided by the Government of Gujarat and/or the Gujarat University.

21 Clarification regarding implementation of NEP 2020 :

As Three Years' LL.B. Programme is a professional Programme, the structure of the programme will depend upon the circulars and instructions published by the Bar Council of India time to time. At present this programme is divided into six semesters. However, the Bar Council of India may change the structure of this programme pursuant to New Education Policy 2020. In such circumstances, this programme structure may be changed by the Gujarat University and the colleges affiliated with it. Such changes, if done shall be binding to the students admitted in any law college affiliated with the Gujarat University.



22 Interpretation :

In implementation of the provisions of these rules, if any difficulty or question arises as to the interpretation of any provision, the decision of the Gujarat University and Government of Gujarat shall be final. However, while interpreting any such provisions of these rules, the Admission Committee shall take into consideration the mandatory provisions of the State Government, Gujarat University as well as the Bar Council of India – Rules of Legal Education -2008 (amended in year 2014) and other circulars, letters as well as the directions issued by the Bar Council of India from time to time. In case of any inconsistency between the above rules and the instructions given by the Education Department, Government of Gujarat and/or its authorized Officer, the later shall prevail. Any dispute arises will fall under Ahmedabad City Jurisdiction only.

4.. PREVENTION AND PROHIBITION OF RAGGING

OBJECTIVES:

In view of the directions of the Honorable Supreme Court in SLP No. 24295 of 2006 dated 16-05-2007 and in Civil Appeal number 887 of 2009, dated 08-05-2009 to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging including any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student or asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student, with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student, in all higher education institutions in the country, and thereby, to provide for the healthy development, physically and psychologically, of all students.

WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING?

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

1. Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
2. Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;
3. Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;
4. Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
5. Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
6. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
7. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;



8. Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student
9. Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Note : The candidate has to give declaration to the Center of Legal Education – Law College at the time of taking admission that he/she shall not indulge into any kind of Ragging Activities and in the event of finding the candidate liable for any activities of ragging during the college education, his/her admission shall be cancelled by the concerned law college/ Center of Legal Education.
