Admissions Process

1. Applicant registers online
2. Applicant starts the application form and fills up all the required details
3. Applicant submits the application form fees
4. Applicant receives a notification on email for the successful submission of the application form
5. The candidate receives the admit card with the online interview link 2 days prior to the registered email id.
6. Candidate attends the online group discussion and personal interview
7. Results Announced
8. On fulfilling the eligibility criteria and successful selection, the candidate receives the provisional offer letter on the registered email ID.
9. The candidate makes the payment through the online payment link provided in the provisional offer letter.
10. Candidate makes the payment for the confirmation of the provisional MBA admission
11. The candidate uploads the required documents in the self-registration link provided.
12. The student section checks the documents submitted and the candidate will receive an email of successful self-registration and the PRN no. will get generated
13. Details of the documents to be submitted, scholarship policy, installment dates, and commencement date will be available in the offer guide sent as an attachment with the provisional offer letter.
