Admissions as per Guidelines issued by the Honorable Supreme Court of India, Medical Council of India and Directorate General of Health Services, MOFHW, New Delhi.

Important instructions to the candidates allotted through centralized counseling by MCC of DGHS, New Delhi for admission to MD/MS (2025-26).

## **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

Candidate should have passed MBBS with a minimum of 50% marks, possessing permanent or provisional registration certificate of MBBS qualification issued by the NMC / the erstwhile Medical Council of India or State Medical Council and have completed one year of internship.

Candidate should be qualified in NEET-PG 2025 conducted by NBE.

Provisional allotment letter from DGHS/mcc.nic.in.

## **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR FOREIGN MEDICAL GRADUATES:**

Indian citizens or overseas citizens of India (OCI) who have obtained their Primary Medical Qualifications from Medical Colleges outside India should have qualified the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (Screening Test) as per Screening Test Regulations, 2002 which is conducted by National Board of Examinations.

They should have been registered with the NMC/ the erstwhile Medical Council of India or State Medical Council and should have completed their internship or likely to complete their internship.

Candidate should be qualified in NEET-PG 2025 conducted by NBE.

## **NOTE:**

a) Candidates who have been allotted through centralized counseling by the MCC of DGHS, New Delhi for admission to MD/MS course in the Deemed to be University for the academic year 2025-26, are advised to report and complete the admission process within the date and time specified in the "Allotment Letter" issued by the DGHS.

13. Proof of identity (Aadhar card and PAN card copy of the Candidate & the Parent)
14. Four Passport size photograph same as affixed on the NEET PG 2025 Result/Rank letter.

#### **FOR NRI SPONSORSHIP CANDIDATES:**

1. Documents claiming that the sponsor is an NRI (Passport and Visa copy of the Sponsor).
2. Affidavit from the Sponsor that he/she will sponsor the entire course fee of the candidate duly notarized.
3. Relationship Affidavit (Relationship of NRI with the Candidate as per the court orders of The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case W.P.(c) No. 689/2017 – Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Ans. Vs Union of India & Ors. dated 22-08-2017).
4. Embassy Certificate of the Sponsor (Certificate from the Consulate issued within last 06 months)).
5. Family Tree notarized by Tehsildar
6. (Above and all the documents according to MCC's latest eligibility criteria-2025)

#### **FOR NRI CANDIDATES**

1. Candidates Passport and Resident Visa
2. Candidates' parents' Resident certificate issued by the Embassy of the country complying the Income Tax Rules

3. Citizenship of the candidate
4. Income Tax documents required as per the Income Tax Act 1961  
*(Above and all the documents according to MCC's latest eligibility criteria-2025)*

### **FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS**

1. Valid Foreign passport
2. Valid Visa Requirement
3. Valid Residential permit in India

*(Above and all the documents according to MCC's latest eligibility criteria-2025)*

**Note:** Degrees / Certificates of candidates must have been recognized and approved by the Association of Indian universities / Commonwealth Universities / International Association of Universities as equivalent to the corresponding Indian degrees / certificates

### ***XIII. The Candidate should also bring the following certificate/s, if applicable:***

1. OBC/SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority (in the standard format as specified in the prospectus/information bulletin– Annexure I & II of NBE). OBC Candidates should not belong to Creamy Layer. SC/ST certificate should be in English or Hindi language. Sub caste should be clearly mentioned in the certificate. Some of the States insist for English version of Caste Certificate. In case the certificate is in regional language, the candidate should carry an attested translated copy of the certificate in English/ Hindi. For OBC candidates, the sub-caste should tally with the Central List of OBC.
2. EWS Certificate issued by the competent authority (in the standard format as specified in the prospectus/information bulletin – Annexure III of NBE).
3. Disability Certificate issued from a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board for 21 Benchmark Disabilities as per the Rights of Persons with Disability Act 2016 (RPWD Act, 2016). (Please check Annexure IV of Information Bulletin of NEET PG 2025 for admission to MD/MS Courses, published by NBE. No other PH certificate, issued by any other Authority/Hospital will be entertained).
  - i. Candidates without original certificates / documents shall not be allowed to take admission in the allotted Medical College.
  - ii. Candidates who have deposited their original documents with any other Institute/College/University and come for admission with a certificate stating that “their original certificates are deposited with institute/college/University” shall not be allowed to take admission in the allotted Medical College.
4. Allotment letter given by DGHS for admission is subject to fulfillment of all eligibility criteria prescribed by the NMC and Medical fitness of the candidates. Those who do not fulfill the prescribed eligibility criteria and not found medically fit will not be admitted to the course of study to which they are allotted by the DGHS.

Any time after counseling period or when seat cannot be surrendered to DGHS.	No refund. Entire course fee (Three year fees) has to be paid by the candidate.

## GENERAL INFORMATION:

- i. If a candidate fails to report on the date and time specified by MCC of DGHS in the allotment order along with the original Certificates/Documents and/or fails to pay the tuition fee by Demand Draft/Electronic Fund Transfer through RTGS with UTR No. (For NRI Students through Wire Transfer) on the day of admission, he/she will not be permitted to proceed with the admission process. The vacancy arising there from will be duly notified to the DGHS.
- ii. If any candidate withdraws from the course of study in which he/she was admitted, after the expiry of the cut-off date prescribed for admission to that course of study or in mid-term and the seat is rendered vacant, the first year fee paid will be forfeited and the student will also be required to remit the “entire course fee” for the remaining years of the course period.
- iii. Students will be governed by all the University rules including rules for refund of fee, disciplinary rules, hostel rules and UGC/NMC Regulations for Curbing the Menace of Ragging.
- iv. At the time of admission, candidates should sign declaration/undertakings declaring that they shall abide by the rules and regulation of the University including anti-ragging Regulations of the UGC/NMC and observe good conduct and behavior and that they are bound by the University rules on payment of fees/refund of fees.
