The Koch Kingdom was established by Biswa Singha in 1527 AD. Biswa Singha organized the strength of his tribes and defeated all neighbouring Bhuyans. His Kingdom was known as Koch Behar, extending from Karatova in the West and Barnadi in the east. Capital of Koch Behar was Kamatapur.

Biswa Singha was contemporary to great Ahom King Suhungmug/Dihingia Raja. Biswa Singha died in 1540.

At the death of Biswa Singha, his son Nara Singha took the throne of Koch Kingdom in the absence of his brothers Malladev and Sukladhvajas they both were studying at Benaras. After hearing the news Malladev and Sukladhvaj came back to their kingdom, raised an army and defeated Nara Singha.

After expelling Nara Singha, Malladev became king and assumed the name Naranarayan Sukladhvaj, as was very skilled in military skills became commander-in-chief and assumed the name Chilarai.

Ahom King Suklengmug and Sukhampha (1552-1603) were contemporary to Naranarayan. The reign of Naranarayan was the most glorious era of Koch Kingdom.

Naranarayan ruled about 50 years and died in 1584. The glory of Koch Kingdom ended with the death of Naranarayan.
