It provides essential details to candidates seeking admission to the Fellow of National Board (FNB) courses for the academic session 2025 under the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS).

Only candidates who have qualified in the Fellowship Entrance Test (FET) conducted by NBEMS are eligible for admission. All courses and admissions to our College are subject to applicable regulations by University / Government / National Medical Commission / National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences / Court.

All candidates have to apply through the Common Counseling process of the National Board for Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS), Government of India. The Notice and information bulletin regarding FNB courses is available on the NBEMS website (<https://natboard.edu.in>). The important dates are available in the NBEMS website. Instructions in the information bulletin are liable to change based on decisions taken by the NBEMS from time to time.

All candidates must be aware of the objectives of the Christian Medical College Vellore which is “the establishment, maintenance and development of a Christian Medical College and Hospitals in India, where women and men shall receive an education of the highest grade in the art and science of medicine and of nursing, or in one or other of the related professions, to equip them in the spirit of Christ for service in the relief of suffering and the promotion of health”.

The aforesaid object is based on the religious percept of “Heal the Sick”, Matthew 10.8.

2. THE ADMISSION PROCESS

The important dates of FET Fellowship Entrance Test (FET) conducted by NBEMS are available on the NBEMS website.

The selection of all candidates for FNB courses for the academic year 2025-26 will be through the Common Counselling process of the National Board for Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS), Government of India. Only candidates allotted to CMC, Vellore during the various rounds of online/offline common counselling process by the NBEMS for the FNB seats, will be admitted.

At the time of admission a Medical check-up will be conducted for all selected candidates. The admission will be subject to medical clearance. Treatment for candidates with pre-existing illnesses will not be covered by the Institution.

The following certificates should be submitted in original at the time of registration for admission:

1. MBBS Degree certificate in original issued by the University.
2. **Screening Test result** obtained from the National Medical Commission for those who have done **MBBS** in other countries.
3. MBBS Course and conduct certificate in original issued by the Principal/Dean.
4. Certificate of completion of Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship (CRRRI) training in original issued by the Principal / Dean.
5. MBBS **Tamil Nadu Medical Council** registration certificate
6. MD/MS/ Degree or DNB certificate or Provisional pass certificate in original issued by the University or Board issued on or before **31-12-2025**.
7. MD/MS/DNB course and conduct certificate in original issued by the Principal/Dean/Head of Institution.
8. MD/MS/DNB course recognition certificate – **Self-attested copy of print-out of NMC website** confirming your additional qualification being “**Recognized**”/ “**Permitted**” as per NMC Act, 2019
9. If additional PG degree qualification is **NOT listed as “Recognized”** on NMC website, please produce one of the following two documents:
 - Additional Qualification Registration Certificate (AQRC) issued by NMC, OR
 - Additional Qualification Registration Certificate (AQRC) issued by **State Medical Council + IMR Certificate (Indian Medical Registry)** issued by NMC wherein said additional PG degree qualification is registered.
 - Any document (Bonafide certificate/ Mark sheet/Attempt Certificate etc. issued by concerned institution/medical college) confirming the name of the institution/medical college from where the Post Graduate Medical qualification (MD/MS/DM/M.Ch./DNB/ DrNB) was pursued.
 - Any other relevant certificate or document such as NOC or relieving order etc.
10. For candidates who have done DNB as their qualifying degree, **No Objection Certificate** in Original issued from the National Board of Examinations, New Delhi.
11. MD/MS/DNB **State Medical Council and Tamil Nadu Medical Council** registration certificate.
12. DM / MCh / DrNB Degree certificate or Provisional pass certificate in original issued by the University or Board.
13. DM / MCh / DrNB course and conduct certificate in original issued by the Principal / Dean / Head of Institution.

14. DM/MCh/DrNB course recognition certificate (as per the provisions of the NMC act, 2019/IMC Act 1956) – self attested copy of printout of NMC website confirming to your additional PG Degree qualification being “Recognized” as per NMC/IMC Act.
15. For candidates who have done DrNB as their qualifying degree, **No Objection Certificate** in Original issued from the National Board of Examinations, New Delhi.
16. DM/MCh/DrNB **Tamil Nadu Medical Council** registration certificate.
17. Migration Certificate in original to be obtained from their respective University.
18. **Transfer certificate** from previous course in original issued by the Principal / Dean of College where broad specialty degree was done.
19. Tamil Nadu Medical Council Registration Certificate for **MBBS** and **additional qualification**. Please note that a ‘No objection certificate’ from the concerned medical council will be required in order to obtain the Tamil Nadu Medical Council Registration *.
20. Original and attested clear photocopy of date of birth certificate (SSLC/H.Sc. Mark sheet).
21. Service obligation completion certificate in original in the case of former Minority Network category students, giving full details of date of commencement and completion of service obligation.
22. Relieving Letter issued by the sponsoring Government employer of the candidate with confirmation of study leave being granted for the period of FNB training and confirmation of payment of salary with applicable allowances as per rules of the sponsoring organization for the entire duration of FNB training, in case the candidate is employed with a Government Organization and joining FNB Programme on study.
23. Relieving letter / Term completion letter from the present / last employer.
24. Four passport-size colour photographs for the issue of an identity card.
 - a. A PEN drive which contains the following files: (i) A passport size colour photograph in JPEG form and (ii) a candidate’s signature. Both the files should be labelled with the name of the candidate and the course. (iii) scanned originals of all above listed documents. **The total file size should not be less than 2 MB.**

International Students must submit in addition to above:

25. **NO OBJECTION** certificate issued by the Medical Council / Government for permission to work in India for the period of Fellowship course.
26. Security Clearance obtained from the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India (Applicable for all those who are required to have security clearance as per the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) requirements)
27. Valid travel document (Passport) and valid permission (visa).
28. **“No Objection Certificate”** from the parent Medical Council / Government for appearing in the examination and permission for working in India for the period of Fellowship.
29. **Temporary Registration** with the National Medical Commission, New Delhi, India for the duration of FNB course shall be required to be obtained on allotment of a FNB seat.
30. Proof of identity (Passport /Voter ID /Driving License) – Please bring all 3 if available.
31. PAN Card.

In addition to the originals, two sets of government gazetted officer attested photocopies of all the above certificates are required at the time of admission.

***Kindly note that if there is any previous incomplete service obligation with any of the State Medical Health Services, which could result in the candidate being unable to obtain a ‘Migration Certificate’ or ‘No objection Certificate’, then it could lead to the candidate being ineligible for admission.**

3. FEES

The candidates will have to pay the Entrance Examination fee to the NBEMS as mentioned in the information bulletin of the NBEMS. The information bulletin is available at <https://natboard.edu.in>

Annual Course Fee

Course Fee:

The 1st year course fee shall be paid by the candidate only by electronic transfer (Internet Payment Gateway) through the counselling portal, and there is no other method of payment for the 1st year course fee

The 1st year course fee has to be paid to NBEMS by all candidates who are allotted the FNB seats in order to confirm their joining.

Course Fee for further years:

Candidates who have joined FNB courses under NBEMS in 2025 are required to pay their second-year course fee directly to the hospital.

The fee shall be paid by the student only through Demand Draft/Cheque / electronic transfer and under no circumstances by cash.

The fee has to be paid after the selection of the student but before joining the allotted training institute.

The candidates will also have to pay Exit Examination Fees as per the eligibility given by the NBEMS.

5. WITHDRAWALS

The rules of the Common counselling process by the National Board for Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS) will be strictly followed. Candidates who are allotted seats and join the course will be expected to complete the whole training period. Those who withdraw from the course thereafter will not be selected for any training course or staff appointment subsequently in this institution.

6. SOME FACILITIES AVAILABLE FOR TRAINEES:

Medical Records Department: In clinical areas, special emphasis is given to medical record keeping. There is a well-organized Medical Record Library in the institution as well as a departmental record system. Facilities are provided in these areas for trainees to conduct retrospective case studies from records.

Research activity of each Department: The Christian Medical College supports an active medical research programme. To broaden this experience, the trainees are encouraged to participate in research activities. A Research Methodology course will be conducted for all newly selected higher specialty students. Attendance for this is mandatory. Failure to do so will result in the candidates forfeiting the privilege of obtaining research grants from the CMC Research Committee.

Accommodation: Partly furnished accommodation may be provided for trainees based on the availability. Candidates are required to vacate their accommodation within 2 weeks of finishing their course. Car parking facility is not available.

Recreation: Facilities for tennis, badminton, basketball, volleyball and table tennis are available

Staff Student Health Clinic: The medical needs of the students and staff of the Christian Medical College are met through the clinic provided for this purpose.

Hepatitis B Vaccination is mandatory for all students. The selected candidates should contact the Staff Student Health Service within one week of joining the course. The candidates have to pay for Vaccination (3 doses and 1 booster dose). Failure to take the Vaccination will make the candidate ineligible for free immunoglobulin in the event of accidental exposure of Hepatitis-B. If the candidate has already been vaccinated elsewhere the serum antibody titres should be confirmed through the Staff Student Health Service. The candidates have to pay for this test.
