SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

(Academic Year 2026-27)



This Scholarship Policy shall apply to students admitted to Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) programs under the University Quota. Students admitted through KCET or any other quota shall not be eligible, unless expressly included under the specific scholarship category. The scholarship under the categories specified herein shall be restricted to prescribed program fee payable directly to REVA University.

1. RISE (REVA Initiative for Scholastic Excellence) Scholarship:

REVA RISE is the flagship Scholarship Aptitude Test of REVA University, instituted to identify, assess, and reward meritorious and high-potential students and the deserving students from rural settings. The initiative is designed to promote academic rigour, analytical ability, and an enterprising outlook among aspiring learners, while enabling deserving students to access quality higher education on a merit-driven basis.

2. MERIT Scholarship

Merit based scholarships are awarded based on the performance in the qualifying examinations or national/state level entrance examinations/tests.

3. Sports Scholarship

Sports scholarships are awarded based on levels of representation in International, National and State level sports.

4. NCC Scholarship

NCC scholarships are awarded based on certificates and participation at different participation levels.

5. Defence/Paramilitary/Police Scholarship

Awarded to the wards of Defence, Paramilitary and Police personnel.

6. Scholarship for Specially Abled

Awarded to the students who are specially/differently abled.

7. Staff Children & Sibling Scholarship

Awarded to the children of REVA University staff and siblings of existing students or a concurrent sibling admission for same admission year.

8. Referral Scholarship

Awarded for the admissions referred by existing students, Alumni and others.

Continuation of REVA RISE Scholarships in subsequent years shall be strictly subject to the student maintaining a minimum of 80% attendance and securing a minimum 8.0 SGPA/CGPA in all subjects in each semester cleared in a single attempt without backlog.

Sports Scholarships shall be granted only upon formal approval from the Sports Department. The scholarship shall be applicable for the first academic year only. Continuation in subsequent years shall be strictly subject to the student's performance in Sports and formal confirmation from the Sports Department, in accordance with its prescribed criteria.

4. NCC Scholarships

NCC Scholarships shall be applicable for the first academic year only, subject to prior approval by the Associate NCC Officer (ANO). Continuation in subsequent years shall be strictly subject to the student's participation in NCC and formal confirmation from the ANO, in accordance with the prescribed criteria.

5. Defence/Paramilitary/Police Scholarships

Defence/Paramilitary/Police Scholarships shall be applicable for the entire duration of the program, subject to prescribed terms and conditions, and a valid certificate issued by the recognized competent authority is submitted.

6. Scholarship for Specially Abled

Category	Percentage of Scholarship
Specially Abled	25%

Specially Abled Scholarships shall be applicable for the entire duration of the program, subject to prescribed terms and conditions, and a valid disability certificate issued by a recognized competent authority must be submitted.

7. Staff Children & Sibling Scholarship

Category	Percentage of Scholarship
Children of REVA University Permanent Staff (up to a maximum of two children of each staff)	25%
Sibling admission (up to a maximum of two siblings)	15%
Concurrent sibling admission (in the same admissions year; up to a maximum of two siblings)	10%

Scholarships to wards of REVA University Permanent staff are for all years (Employee ID, employment details, relationship proof must be furnished).

Sibling Scholarships shall be applicable for the first academic year only (The SRN of the currently enrolled sibling must be furnished. In the case of simultaneous admission of siblings in the same academic year, an undertaking from the parent shall be submitted at the time of admission).

8. Referral Scholarship

Category	Percentage of Scholarship

Alumni Referral	8%
Student Referral	5%

Referral Scholarships shall be applicable for the first academic year only (Employee/Alumni/Student ID and relevant details must be furnished).

1. Scholarship Allocation:

Scholarships stipulated in the above policy will be allocated on first come first served basis. The allocation of scholarships shall cease once the approved limit is reached or at the sole discretion of REVA University.

2. One Scholarship Policy:

A student may avail only one scholarship or fee waiver under any category.

3. Determination and Award:

All scholarships are determined strictly at the time of admission, or prior to the generation of Student Registration Number (SRN) in circumstances where academic records are submitted later (i.e., pending results) for any leftover scholarship seats.

4. Eligibility Criteria:

Scholarships are awarded based on the eligibility criteria prescribed for each category, however fulfilment of the minimum eligibility conditions does not automatically guarantee an award, as scholarships are subject to availability.

5. Change of Program

In the event of a change of program or branch after admission, the scholarship may be revised or withdrawn based on eligibility for the new program.

6. Document Verification

All scholarships are subject to verification of original documents. Submission of false, fabricated, incomplete, or misleading information will result in immediate cancellation of admission and scholarship, along with recovery of any financial benefit extended.

7. Fee Adjustment and Refunds

Scholarships are applicable only on the tuition fees, and do not cover examination fees, hostel fees, mess charges, transport charges, caution deposits, application fees or any other ancillary charges other than annual tuition fee. In case of withdrawal or cancellation of admission, refund (if any) shall be governed by the REVA University's refund policy, and scholarship benefits will stand forfeited.

8. Discretion of the University

The University reserves the right to amend, revise, or withdraw any scholarship scheme, eligibility norms, or percentage of award at its sole discretion without prior notice. The decision of the University in all scholarship matters shall be final and binding.

9. Compliance with Regulatory Guidelines

All scholarship awards shall be subject to applicable statutory, regulatory, and governmental guidelines in force from time to time.
