Topic Area	Key Topics
Vocabulary	Synonyms, Antonyms, Word usage, Idioms & Phrases
Grammar	Tenses, Subject-verb agreement, Modals, Prepositions, Articles, Pronouns
Reading Comprehension	Short/long passages, inference, tone, main idea
Verbal Skills	Para-jumbles, Sentence completion, Error spotting, Cloze tests
Written Expression	Basic editing, concise rewriting, correct sentence formation

Arithmetic	Percentages, Ratio & Proportion, Profit & Loss, Averages, Time & Work, Time-Speed-Distance, Simple & Compound Interest
Algebra	Linear equations, Quadratic basics, Simplification, Sequences
Number System	HCF/LCM, Divisibility, Remainders, Factors
Geometry / Mensuration	Basic geometry (triangles, circles), Area & Perimeter, Volume basics
Data Interpretation	Tables, Bar/Line graphs, Pie charts, Data-sufficiency, Caselets

Verbal Reasoning	Syllogisms, Coding & Decoding, Statements & Conclusions/Assumptions
Analytical / Non-verbal	Series (number/letter), Pattern recognition, Mirror/Water images, Venn diagrams
Puzzles & Arrangements	Seating arrangements (linear/circular), Scheduling, Matrix puzzles, Directions
Logical Puzzles	Statements & Arguments, Cause & Effect, Strong vs Weak arguments, Data Sufficiency
