FACILITY FOR OPTION CONFIRMATION/REGISTRATION**

The activities related to the second phase allotment to MBBS/BDS courses for the State Quota Seats available in Government Colleges and the seats available in Self financing Colleges have commenced.

Online Option Confirmation is mandatory

Those Candidates who want their higher order options in MBBS/BDS courses to be considered in the second phase allotment, shall have to log into their Home page and confirm their options by clicking the 'confirm' button available therein. After Online Option confirmation, the candidates can re-arrange their higher order options/ delete the unwanted options Courses/colleges if applicable, **till 23.09.2025, 11.00 AM**, through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. Online option confirmation is mandatory for those who have got admission and those who have no allotment as per the first phase allotment, to consider them in the second phase allotment. But for those who do not confirm their options after first phase of admission, the admission received, if any, in the first phase shall be retained. Those admitted candidates who wish to vacate the seats received through first phase allotment can vacate the seats on or before **22.09.2025, 5.00 PM**, such candidates will not be considered for further rounds of centralised allotment to MBBS/BDS courses. **Option registration** facility will be available during this phase for **Government Medical College , Wayanad and Government Medical College , Kasaragod .**

On the basis of options received up to **11.00 AM on 23.09.2025** , the second phase provisional allotment to MBBS/BDS courses will be published in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** on 24.09.2025. Candidates who

receive allotment in this phase shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/balance fee (if applicable) and join the course/college allotted.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE OF THE ALLOTMENT

15.09.2025	Website opens for Online Option confirmation and for enabling re-arrangement of higher options/deletion of unwanted options for MBBS/BDS courses.
23.09.2025,11.00 AM	Time for Online Option Confirmation and re-arrangement/ deletion of options ends.
24.09.2025	Publication of Second Allotment (Provisional)
25.09.2025	Publication of Second Phase final Allotment
26.09.2025 to 30.09.2025,4.00 PM	Time for joining to the allotted colleges after paying required fees.
30.09.2025, 5.00 PM	College authorities shall approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through OAMS.

FEES

The details of fee for the MBBS/BDS courses, in various colleges is available in the website. As the fee for 2025-26 academic year is not yet fixed in Self Financing Medical colleges, those candidates who get allotment in Self Financing Medical colleges should provisionally pay the fee fixed for 2024-25 academic year and they have to pay the balance fees in case if the fee to be fixed by the Admission Supervisory Committee/Government/Hon'ble High Court for the academic year 2025-26 is going to be higher than that of 2024-25 for these colleges.

TOKEN FEES

- Those candidates who get allotment to MBBS/BDS courses in Self-financing colleges should pay the fee/balance fee (if applicable) as shown in the allotment memo to the allotted college.
- Those candidates who get allotment to Government Medical/Dental courses should pay the complete fee to Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC/Fishermen category and those having benefits as per G.O((MS)25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O(MS)10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sree Chitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home should not pay the token fee. However, if such students are allotted under

Minority/NRI quota seats in Self-Financing Medical/Dental colleges, they will have to remit the token fee as prescribed above and they will not be eligible for any fee concession.

Note:

1. Candidates are advised to confirm options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted.
2. Those NRI candidates who have submitted expired or expiring documents along with Online application and have submitted Self declaration from the sponsor can confirm options. If such candidates do not submit the original valid documents on or before the last date fixed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, the allotment if any, received in NRI quota and the NRI status will be cancelled.
