SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT TO
POST GRADUATE NURSING COURSES (PG NURSING) - 2025
FACILITY FOR ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION

The activities related to the Second Phase of Centralised Allotment for admission to Post Graduate Nursing Course (PG Nursing) in Government Nursing Colleges and Private Self Financing Nursing Colleges in the state commenced in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Candidates who have already submitted online options in the first phase and who want to participate in this phase of allotment must confirm their existing options by clicking the ‘**Confirm**’ button available in the home page. After online option confirmation, such candidates can delete the unwanted higher options and can re-arrange their existing higher options. The facility for online option confirmation/ deletion/ rearrangement will be available on the Website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** up to **13.10.2025, 11.59 PM**. Those who do not confirm their options online within the stipulated time, will not be considered for allotment.

Those candidates who have received an allotment and taken admission and continuing in the admission status in the allotted nursing college in the first phase shall have to confirm their online options to be considered for this

phase of allotment. The present admission during the first phase of allotment, if any, of candidates who do not confirm their higher options within the stipulated time shall be retained.

The schedule for the second phase option confirmation is given below:

10.10.2025	Website opens for enabling online option confirmation/re- arrangement/ deletion of existing options.
13.10.2025, 11.59 PM	Facility for online option confirmation/rearrangement / deletion of options ends.
14.10.2025	Publication of second phase of allotment (Provisional)
15.10.2025	Publication of second phase of allotment (Final)
16.10.2025 to 18.10.2025, 3.00 PM	All candidates who get allotment shall remit the fee as shown in the allotment memo to the colleges allotted and join at the college.
18.10.2025, 4.00 PM	Heads of Institutions should submit admission status through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) to the office of CEE

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per Clause 7 of the Prospectus at the time of admission. Candidates allotted to colleges, should take admission in the colleges and shall remit the fee shown in the Allotment Memo at the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. SC/ST/OEC candidates/ children of Registered Fishermen/inmates of Sree Chitra Home, Nirbhaya Home, and Government Juvenile Justice Homes allotted against merit seats are exempted from payment of fees.

Important:

1. Candidates who do not take admission within the specified dates shall lose their allotment.
2. Candidates, who receive a change of allotment to their higher options in the second phase of allotment, will automatically lose their current admission of the first phase. If the candidates has a change of college to their higher options in the second phase they should obtain the T.C and

relevant documents from their currently admitted colleges and join the newly allotted colleges within the specified date and time notified by the CEE.
