SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT TO PG PHARMACY

(M.PHARM) COURSE- 2025

FACILITY FOR SECOND PHASE ONLINE OPTION REGISTRATION

The activities related to the second phase of centralized allotment to PG Pharmacy Course for the year 2025 has commenced. Candidates who have already got allotment in various Pharmacy Colleges and those who have no allotment through the first phase allotment can register online options to be considered for second phase of online allotment. The Candidates who want allotment in the PG Pharmacy course to be considered for second phase allotment shall have to log into their Home Page available in the link 'M.Pharm-2025 Candidate Portal' and register their options by clicking the "option registration". The candidates can register options from 25.11.2025 to 27.11.2025, 6.00 PM, through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. Online option registration is mandatory for those who wish to get admission in the Second Phase Allotment. On the basis of options received up to 27.11.2025, 6.00 PM, the provisional allotment will be published in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in on 28.11.2025. Candidates who receive an allotment in this phase shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee at the allotted college from 01.12.2025 to 03.12.2025 and join the allotted course/college before 4.00 PM on 03.12.2025. The schedule for the second phase allotment is given below:

25.11.2025 to 27.11.2025, 6.00 PM	Start of Option registration
27.11.2025, 6.00 PM	End of Online Option registration
28.11.2025	Publication of Provisional Allotment
29.11.2025	Publication of Final Allotment
01.12.2025 to 03.12.2025, 4.00 PM	Joining Time
03.12.2025, 5 PM	All the college authorities should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS)

Candidates allotted to the courses/college should remit the fee mentioned in the allotment slip at the college allotted and take admission as per the schedule prescribed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Candidates who do not remit the prescribed fees/take admission within the stipulated time will lose their allotment. Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sree Chitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home need not remit fees. Notification regarding Mop up counselling as per clause 12.9 of the prospectus, if any, will be issued later.
