ALLOTMENT TO PG MEDICAL COURSES- 2025

SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT

FACILITY FOR OPTION CONFIRMATION/

DELETION/REARRANGEMENT

AVAILABLE

The second phase Centralized allotment to Post Graduate Medical Degree Courses for the academic year 2025-26 in the State commences from 10.12.2025.

Candidates including Service Quota candidates included in the State merit lists published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can log in to the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** and then click the link '**PG Medical 2025-Candidate Portal**' to access their home page. Candidates can then re-arrange/delete their existing higher order options if needed after clicking the '**Confirm**' button available therein. Candidates who have not received any allotment in the first phase can also rearrange/delete their existing options. The facility for online option confirmation/deletion/re-arrangement shall be available in the above website from **10.12.2025 to 17.12.2025, 05:00 PM.**

Option Confirmation is mandatory

In the Second Phase counseling, there is no facility for fresh option registration for candidates. Option confirmation/deletion/re-arrangement of the existing options is possible in this phase. Option confirmation is mandatory to participate in in this phase. If a candidate was allotted a seat in the first phase and joined the allotted seat, his/her higher options (those above the allotted option) are available for confirmation/deletion/re-arrangement in this phase and all the lower options (those below the allotted option) have automatically been deleted thus allowing only up-gradation to a higher option or retention of the same seat. If a candidate who joined the course allotted in the first phase does not confirm that the higher options are to be considered for allotment in the second phase, he/she will not be considered for up-

gradation in the second phase, but the seat allotted in the first phase will be retained. So, if a candidate who joined the course allotted in the first phase does not want up-gradation in the second phase, he/she need not confirm the higher options or delete the higher options.

The candidates who were allotted a seat in the first phase but did not take admission in the respective colleges within the stipulated time and those candidates who quit the seats after taking admission will lose their present allotment as well as all the higher order options and will not be considered for the second phase allotment except that options registered for the newly added courses/colleges, if any. The registration fee of such candidates who did not join within the stipulated time after getting the allotment in the first phase and those candidates who quit the seats after taking admission is considered as penalty and will not be refunded.

Eligibility for participating in the Second phase allotment:

- Candidates who have received an allotment in the first phase and got admitted to the allotted colleges and continue in their admitted status.
- Candidates who have not received any allotment in the first phase, and who want to be considered for the second phase of allotment.

Candidates who will be excluded from Phase 2:

- A candidate who was allotted a seat in the first phase of the State counseling but did not join the allotted seat.
- A candidate who joined the allotted seat in the first phase of the State counseling but after that vacated the seat.

Tentative schedule for the second phase allotment

10.12.2025	Website opens for enabling Online Option Confirmation, rearrangement/deletion of existing higher options.
17.12.2025, 05.00 PM	Facility for Online Option Confirmation and rearrangement/deletion of options ends.
19.12.2025	Publication of second phase provisional allotment.
20.12.2025	Publication of second phase final allotment.
22.12.2025 to 28.12.2025, 4.00 PM	All candidates who receive an allotment must join the course/college to which they are allotted. They are required to submit the necessary documents and pay

	the prescribed fee at the respective colleges.
28.12.2025, 5.00 PM	College authorities shall have to approve and submit the list of admitted candidates to the CEE through the Online Admission Management System (OAMS)

Candidates allotted to courses, shall remit the prescribed fee at the college and take admission in the college-course allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. Candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

Note:

1. Fresh option registration will be available during the third (final) Phase as per Prospectus Clause 10.1.18 (3).
2. The registration fee of candidates who fail to join within the stipulated time after receiving an allotment, as well as those who quit their seats after taking admission, will be treated as a penalty and will not be refunded.
3. The allotment to Colleges/Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies/Affiliation from the University concerned.
