General instructions for students including application fee details

- Last Date** for the submission of online applications is **17th May 2026 (23.59.59 hours)** and **last date for offline application is 1st June 2026** [for B.Ed. Spl.Ed.(HI)] and **30th June 2026** (for M.Ed. Spl.Ed.(HI) & PGDAVT)
- Online / Offline application:** Candidates are instructed to carefully read and acquaint themselves with the Prospectus uploaded on the AIISH website before applying:
 - The prospectus 26-27 can be downloaded from the AIISH website www.aiishmysore.in.
 - Candidates shall apply **only online** for **B. ASLP / M.Sc. (Audiology) / M.Sc. (Speech Language Pathology)** programmes.
 - Candidates who wish to appear for **both M.Sc. (Aud.) and M.Sc. (SLP) Entrance Examinations** must submit **separate online applications** for each programme.
 - For non-entrance-based programmes (M. Ed, B. Ed & PGDAVT), the hard copy of the duly filled and signed application form (available in the website) must be sent to The Director, AIISH, Manasagangothri, Mysuru - 570006** on or before the prescribed due date.
 - Online submission of the application form shall be made through the link

provided on the AIISH website: www.aiishmysore.in.

- Candidates who do not comply with the instructions given in this leaflet and the Prospectus 2026–27 will be summarily disqualified.
- For Diploma and Ph D, separate notifications will be issued as and when notified by RCI and AIISH/UOM.

4. **Choose Examination Centre:** At the time of online submission of the application form, candidates are required to select **any three cities** in the order of preference in which he/she wants to take the online test. The choice of cities shall be subject to the **availability of test centres**, and allotment will be made on a **first-come, first-served basis**. During the submission of the online application form, candidates will be able to view and select **only those cities where slots are available**. The **final allotment of the test centre / venue** shall be made by **AIISH**.
5. Requests for **change of test centre/city** will **not be entertained**. Candidates are advised **not to canvass** for the same.
6. The **exact address and location of the test centre** shall be indicated on the **admit card**. The **specific guidelines to be adhered to at the examination centre** will be provided in the admit card and also displayed on the **Institute's website**.
7. **Download Admit Card:** Candidates are required to download their **admit card** through their **registered login ID/ registration number credentials**. The link for login will be displayed on the website as per the specified date announced by the Institute. **Admit**

card will NOT be sent to the candidates by Post/email.

8. **Candidates MUST bring the following documents to the test Centre:**

a) Printed copy of the **Admit Card**

b) Any one of the following **valid original photo ID proofs** (non-expired) / PAN Card / Driving License / Voter ID / Passport / Aadhaar Card (With photograph) / web downloaded Aadhaar copy.

9. **With regard to category**, the information furnished in the online application form will remain same for the purpose of assignment of selection and no change will be entertained in future for any reason. The student should produce the category certificate in the prescribed format without fail during the verification of original documents. All claims made in the application must be supported with adequate documentary proof at the time of counselling.

10. Therefore, candidates must ensure that the **mobile number and e-mail address** entered in the online application form **belong to them** and are **valid and active**.

11. All OTP-related communication shall be made through e-mail and/or SMS only.

12. For the latest updates, candidate must keep visiting the AIISH website www.aiishmysore.in till the completion of final round of counselling / admission.

13. **All-important announcements will be displayed on AIISH website and no personal communication through email or SMS will be made.**

14. If any of the information furnished in the online application form is found to be false / incorrect, **the application is liable to be rejected** and the seat allotted to the candidate, if any, is also liable to be cancelled and the entire fee amount paid by such candidate shall be forfeited.

15. If the information furnished by the candidates in the application form or any other document/s submitted by the candidates / parents are found to be false / incorrect / tampered / forged, such candidate's selection will be cancelled at any point of time

during his / her course of study and criminal proceedings as per rules will be initiated by the institute against the candidate.

16. The candidates and their parents are strictly advised not to resort to any canvassing, directly or indirectly, to support their applications. Canvassing in any form is strictly prohibited and will be considered as a serious disqualification.

18. Prior to the announcement of the **All India Rank List**, the **answer key** will be published on the Institute website to enable candidates to submit discrepancies, if any. A maximum period of **24 hours** will be provided for this purpose. **No further representations** shall be entertained thereafter.
19. **The results**, along with the final answer keys, will be published on the AIISH website: www.aiishmysore.in. The provisional list of candidates selected on merit will also be displayed on the website. No individual communication will be sent in this regard. The provisional list of candidates called for counselling and the waitlist, if any, will be notified only on the Institute website. Candidates and parents are advised to visit the website regularly for updates and announcements.
20. Information regarding selected and waitlisted candidates and their dates of interview/counselling will be displayed only on the Institute's website. The candidates are advised to visit the website from time to time. **Individual intimation will NOT be sent to both selected and non-selected candidates** and no further correspondence on this will be entertained.
21. Candidates selected for B. ASLP / M.Sc. (Aud.) / M.Sc. (SLP) programs have to be prepared to travel to Mysuru (for admission) at a short notice to attend the counselling program.
22. Candidates will be called for personal counselling at AIISH in the order of their rank in the merit list obtained in the AIISH Entrance Examination. Candidates selected during counselling shall be admitted on the same day, subject to payment of the prescribed admission fees in full and submission of original mark cards and other required documents for verification by the University of Mysore. Candidates who are called for counselling but fail to report by 10.00 a.m. on the day of counselling, or do not complete the admission process on the same day, shall forfeit the offered seat. In such cases, the seat will be offered to the next eligible candidate in the merit list.
23. Verification of all the original documents will be made at the time of counselling. The candidates should bring the below mentioned documents, as applicable, for counselling. Candidates failing to produce any of the required documents shall not be considered for admission. **Candidates are also instructed to come with the scanned**

copies of all the documents separately in .pdf format of less than 200kb size of each file and passport size photograph and his/her signature in .jpg format of not more than 80kb size each in a pen-drive for registering their candidature in the Unified University and College Management System (UUCMS) portal.

Documents to be submitted by all Candidates (Two set of photocopies should also be submitted.):

- a) Original marks card of X std.
- b) Original marks card of the qualifying examination (PUC/XII Std.)
- c) Recent Passport size colour photo – 6 Nos.
- d) Original Degree Certificate and Original marks card of the Degree examination, Internship completion certificate (applicable only for PG programmes)
- e) Migration Certificate (if applicable)
- f) Transfer (TC), Character and Conduct certificate
- g) Indemnity bond (*Annexure – III in the prospectus 2026-27*)
- h) Photocopy of Aadhaar Card

In addition, the candidates belonging to the following categories are to submit the following additional documents:

EWS/SC/ST/OBC (NCL) Candidates (as applicable)

- Caste certificate/Income and Asset's certificate issued by the competent authority.
- Latest OBC (NCL) certificate in the prescribed format (*Annexure-I in the prospectus 2026-27*) for Central Educational Institutions mentioning non-creamy layer status for the financial year 2025-26 issued by an appropriate authority. The caste mentioned should be listed in www.ncbc.nic.in OBC list.
- Economically Weaker Section (EWS) certificate issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format for the last financial year (2025-26) (*Annexure-II in the prospectus 2026-27*)

Physically Challenged Candidates

- PC certificate issued by competent authority as per the prevailing Rules of PWD Act 2016.

North Eastern State Candidates

- Domicile certificate/Document in support of having passed XII Std from NE States.

Foreign Students

- Foreign passport/Document in support of having passed XII Std. from a foreign country; Equivalency certificate (Formalities to be completed at University of Mysore)
- Necessary clearance from Ministry of External Affairs, Govt. of India in case of applicants holding foreign passport.

24. Candidates who could not get admission under General Merit quota subsequently, their candidature will be considered under Self-Financing Scheme (SFS) in the order of ranking and reservation.
25. Candidates who withdraw from the program, cancel their admission for any reason, **or** are removed from the program for any reason, shall forfeit all payments made to the Institute and the University. Candidates who withdraw from the program after the last date of admission or after commencement of classes **shall be** required to execute an Indemnity Bond, as prescribed.
26. All students (including Post-Doctoral Fellows) taking admission to various programs and receiving stipend/fellowship from the Institute are required to submit an Indemnity Bond on a non-judicial stamp paper of the value of ₹200/- (For contents of the bond please refer Prospectus 2025-26). The bond, duly completed in all respects shall be submitted at the time of admission or within 7 days from the date of admission. However, the admission process will complete only after the submission of the bond. Failure to submit the bond within the stipulated time will result in cancellation of admission.

AIISH Entrance Examination for B.ASLP Program

1. The exam shall be conducted on a single day in a single session.
2. The examination will be conducted in four subjects, namely Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and Mathematics. All candidates, except those applying under the Foreign Quota, are required to appear for the entrance examination in three of the four subjects, with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects, and either Biology or Mathematics as the third subject. The examination will be based on the CBSE syllabus of Classes XI and XII.
3. The entrance examination will consist of multiple-choice questions (MCQs) and will be conducted on a Computer-Based Test (CBT) platform.
4. The examination will comprise 150 multiple-choice questions (single correct/best response) in the English language only. The total duration of the examination will be 150 minutes. The question paper will be divided into three parts—Physics, Chemistry, and Biology/Mathematics—each consisting of 50 questions carrying 50 marks.
5. Allocation of marks:

6. Under no circumstances re-examination will be conducted for those who fail to appear for the entrance examination on the scheduled date and time.
7. A merit list will be prepared based on the total marks obtained from all the three subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics).
8. In the event of tie of total score -
 - a. If there is a tie of total score between PCB & PCM candidates, then candidates who appeared for Biology paper of the entrance examination will get preference.
 - b. If there is a tie of total score between PCB candidates, then the relative position of the two candidates will be decided on the marks obtained in Biology followed by Physics and Chemistry.
 - c. If there is a tie of total score between PCM candidates, then the relative position of the two candidates will be decided on the marks obtained in Physics followed by

Chemistry and Mathematics.

- d. In case of a tie even after the above conditions, then age of the candidate shall decide the ranking. Candidates who are older will be placed at a better merit position.

AIISH Entrance Examination for M.Sc. (Audiology) and M.Sc. (Speech Language Pathology)

1. There will be two separate entrance examinations for M.Sc. (Audiology) and M.Sc. (Speech Language Pathology) programmes. Candidates who wish to appear for both M.Sc. (Aud.) and M.Sc. (SLP) entrance examination should apply separately for the two programmes.
2. Both the exams will be conducted on a single day in two separate sessions.
3. The syllabus will be the one meant for the B.ASLP program issued by Rehabilitation Council of India. Kindly refer to the RCI website <http://www.rehabcouncil.nic.in/.org> for complete document.
4. The entrance examination will consist of multiple-choice questions (MCQs) and will be conducted on a Computer-Based Test (CBT) platform.
5. The examination will comprise 100 multiple-choice questions (single correct/best response) in the English language only for 100 marks. Time allotted is 100 minutes. The question paper will be divided into 3 parts (Part A, B and C) each containing 20, 10 and 70 MCQs respectively. The distribution of MCQs in these parts shall be as per Para 8 and 9 below.
