COLLEGE PROFILE

Thiagarajar College, founded on 7th July 1949, was formally inaugurated on 12th October 1949 by His Excellency, the King of Bhavnagar, the then Governor of Madras State. The college is a Private and aided co-educational institution affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University.

The college has come a very long way from the time of its inception, with the significant contribution of the founder, the great philanthropist Karumuttu Thiagarajan Chettiar and the committed service and support of the members of his family, late Dr. (Mrs.) Radha Thiagarajan (then Emeritus President) and late Shri Karumuttu T. Kannan. From its inception, the college remains one of the premier institutions in Madurai. It is meticulously managed by Kalaithanthai Karumuttu Thiagarajan Chettiar Memorial Trust.

The motto of the college is "அறிவும் அன்புமே சுவம்" which means "Wisdom and love is divine". The college was started with only three undergraduate programmes but now has grown in stature with 31 UG, 16 PG and 10 Ph.D. programmes in addition to 14 Diploma and 20 Certificate courses. The college has a total strength of 5562 students, among them girls are 3080, boys are 2482, along with 273 Teaching and 122 Non-teaching staff.

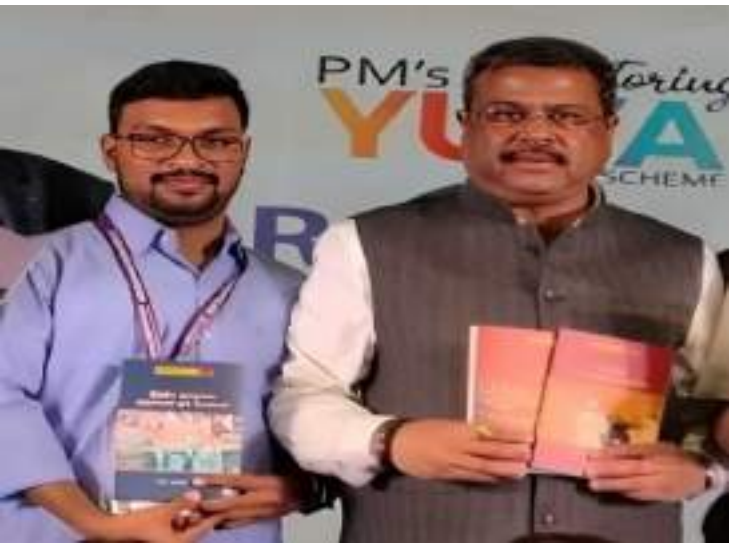

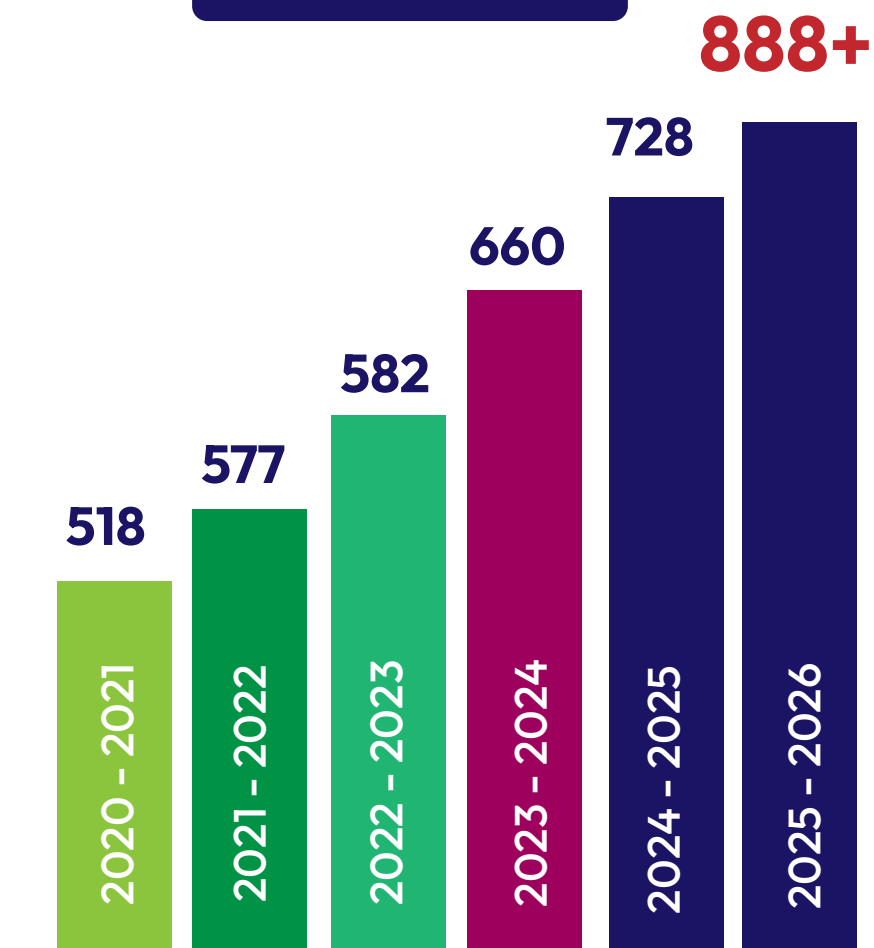

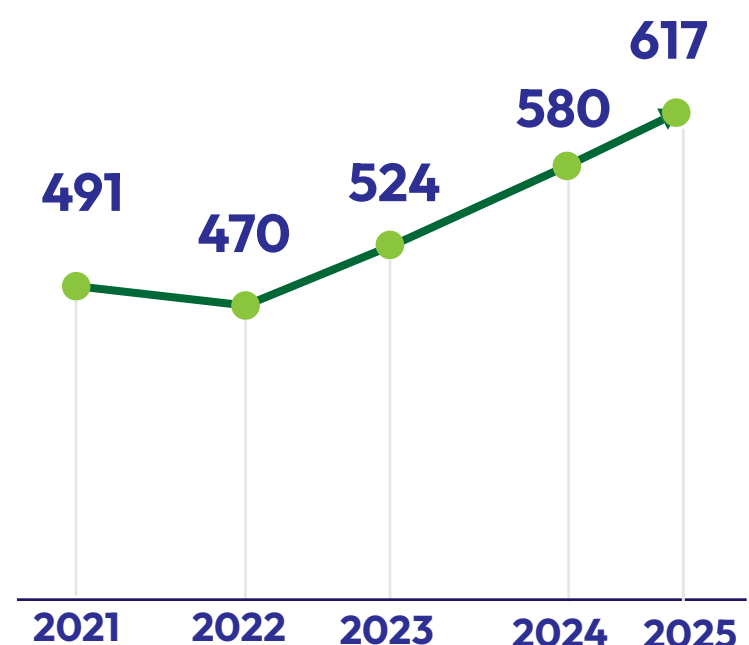

INFRASTRUCTURE

The infrastructure is upgraded with palatial buildings of architectural excellence along with classrooms, lab facilities, library, sports gadgets, auditoriums and green initiatives

Library

The General Library and the Department Libraries have more than 1,10,212 books on various subjects. The library is fully automated and has an archive of **3101** rare books in all disciplines. The periodical section has back-



- volumes of journals in all the disciplines. Library has been upgraded with nearly 107 periodicals, journals, dailies, weeklies and fortnightlies, 60 Talking Books (Ro-talk-audio cassettes) and 300 audio resources for the visually-challenged students. The library is automated with Modern Lib Software and all the department libraries are interconnected. Issuing of books at the departments is also monitored from the General Library. It also has a membership in INFLIBNET and DELNET for accessing e-resources such as e-Shodh Sindhu, Shodhganga, e-books, ejournals. Students are encouraged to borrow books from the general library and advised to return them within the stipulated period of time without fail. Web OPAC access is available for all.

Central Instrumentation Centre

Central Instrumentation Centre with modern instruments facilitates the research culture in the college. This facility is also extended to the research scholars of other institutions.

Museum and Herbarium

The Zoological Museum is an archive of invertebrate and vertebrate specimens. The skeleton of elephant, alligator, variety of snakes, mollusks, birds, embryological specimens including human embryo, and horns of deers are worth mentioning and are utilised for teaching. Herbarium and other specimens such as algae in the Department of Botany remain as realia for teaching Taxonomy.

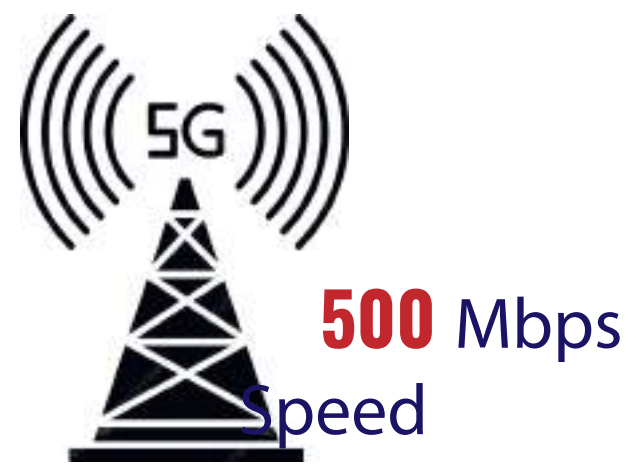

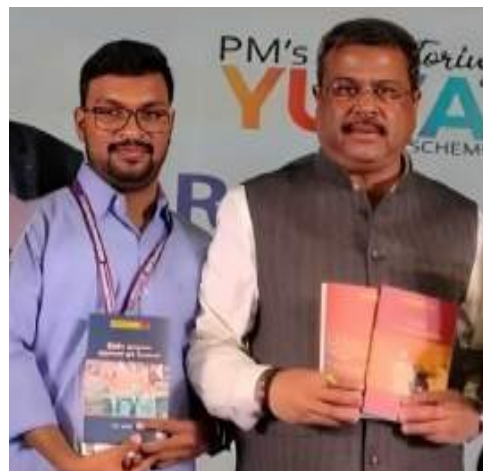
- The college is under 24 hours vigilance by Security personnel with Ex- Service men as Security and Assistant Security Officers.

- Out of the quota of 50% (26.5% BC, 3.5% for BCM and 20% MBC) reserved for BC, MBC and DNC, 5 out of every 100 seats shall be reserved.
