Information to candidates admitted through JoSAA / CSAB and coming for Physical Reporting (August 20 - 23, 2025)

Physical Reporting

All candidates allotted a seat through JoSAA / CSAB special round of counseling are mandatorily required to physically report in the institute on any of the reporting days during August 20 - 23, 2025. The candidates are required to bring the following for submission & physical document verification at the time of Physical Reporting at School of Studies of Engineering and Technology (Formerly Institute of Technology), Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya Bilaspur:

(A) Recent passport size color photograph (5 Nos.)

(B) All required documents / certificate in original with two set of self-attested photocopies as given below:

- 1. Provisional Admission/Allotment letter from JoSAA / CSAB-2025.
- 2. Admit card of JEE (Main).
- 3. Score card of JEE (Main).
- 4. Certificate for proof of age (Class X certificate) or date of birth certificate.
- 5. Mark sheet & Pass Certificate of Class X & XII (Qualifying Examination).
- 6. Category Certificate (GEN-EWS / OBC-NCL / SC / ST), if applicable as per Government of India format, available on the JoSAA / CSAB-2025 website, issued by the competent authority. In case of OBC-NCL / EWS category, the certificate must be issued on or after April 01, 2025 or validity should be mentioned (at least up to August 31, 2025).
- 7. Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) issued by Maharashtra State must be validated by Social Welfare department (in case of SC and OBC-NCL category) and Tribal Welfare department (in case of ST category) of Maharashtra Government. The SC / ST / OBC-NCL candidates of Maharashtra State have to produce their caste validity certificate in the format available in JoSAA-2025 brochure.
- 8. Undertaking by OBC-NCL candidates (as available on JoSAA-2025 portal)
- 9. ST Certificate from Tamil Nadu state must be issued by the concerned Revenue Divisional Officer.
- 10. Valid UDID Card / Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PWD), if applicable, issued by the Competent Authority.
- 11. Transfer Certificate (from the Institute last attended) [original].
- 12. Migration Certificate (from the Board last attended) [original].

- 13. Character Certificate (from the Institute last attended) [original].
- 14. Gap Certificate (Affidavit on stamp paper of Rs 50/-), if passed class XII in academic year 2023 or 2024.
- 15. Medical Certificate [original] as per the JoSAA Format.
- 16. Any Govt. Issued Identity Card, preferably Aadhar Card / Driving license.
- 17. Any Govt. Issued Identity Card of the parents, preferably Aadhar Card.

Note:- The candidates should bring all documents in original. Website copy of the document will not be valid for physical verification. Candidates may have their return reservations on the same day of reporting after 19:00 hours (07 pm).

Hostel Accommodation
