Second round seat allotment for admission to PG medical courses (Non-inservice)

The instructions and schedule for the second round seat allotment of PG NEET-2025 for admission to PG medical courses have been published on the KEA Website in the notification dated 08-12-2025 / 13-12-2025. Since the AIQ Second Round schedule has been revised by MCC on 17-12-2025, the second round seat allotment will be done as per the following revised schedule. 4	Downloading of admission order (candidate copy) by fee paid candidates. Payment of fees and Downloading of Admission Order. Fee paid by Choice 2 candidates will be adjusted upon selection of a seat in this round. Balance fee if any should be paid by the candidates.	25-12-2025 to 30-12-2025 [Candidates are advised to know about the bank working days for making the payment]
	Candidates should report to the college for admission along with; admission order (candidate copy), one set of Photocopies of all Annexure / documents, Aadhar Card, Verification Slip, Mobile Handset to receive OTP, after OTP authentication and Photo Verification (Face Recognition) college authority will download the COLLEGE COPY of admission order. Then only the admission at the college is stated as completed.
