

Spot Round Admission Notice PG Programs

Notice Date: 02-08-2025

Applications are invited from students for following programs in the physical mode spot round. The vacant seats programs list is indicated in the table below. The students are hereby advised to apply by visiting the campus using one of the following two options as applicable in their case. The admissions eligibility criteria and other details are as per the University Brochure for current admission cycle 2025-26 and other related notices at University Website.

Option 1 – CUET Based Admissions: - The students who have appeared in CUET exam for PG admissions may eligible. Merit calculated on the basis of PG CUET scorecard.

Option2 - The students who are willing to apply based on their Graduation marks (Non-CUET) may also eligible. The admission shall be given on the merits of the marks obtained in the qualifying degree.

Please note that first priority shall be given to the student applications at option1. In case seats are still left vacant for respective category in the Program, “applications under option2” shall be considered for admission.
